Joseph Samuel Culbertson (1880-1947)

Joseph Samuel Culbertson was born December 7th 1879 ⁱ to Samuel Culbertson and Julia Nunemaker in Alliance, Stark County, Ohio. ¹-²

In 1880 six-month-old Joseph lived with his mother, Julia, and his sister, Mary, in the home of David and Elizabeth Bricky in Newton, Trumbull County, Ohio. His mother was working as a house keeper.

By 1900 19-year-old Joe Culbertson, born November 1880, worked as a day laborer in Tell Township, Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania. He was a border in the home of George and Belle Kerney. Tell Township is about 25 miles north of Kistler, Perry County, where Joseph's Culbertson family lived.

• George was born October 1830 in PA, and Belle in March 1860 in PA. They have been married for three years. Belle had one child, and one was still living, a son, Alva, born November 1897 in PA. George had a daughter with a previous wife, Lottie, born December 1891 in PA.

While living and working in Tell Township, Joseph met Lillie May Chestnut. He was 23 years old when he married, Lillie May Chestnut ³ on May 28th 1903 in Perry County, Pennsylvania. Lillie identified her age as 19 years, 6 months, and 12 days. Her parent's names were Daniel and Gazildia Chestnut.

• At the time Joseph lived in the Kistler, Shady Hill area of Madison Township, Perry County. Lillie was living in Waterloo, ⁱⁱ Juniata County, Pennsylvania. ⁴

Lillie May Chestnut was born November 7th 1886 to Daniel Chestnut and Gazildia Wilson in Waterloo, Perry County. 5

After they married, Joseph and Lillie moved to Juniata County. In December 1906 when their daughter, Grace, was born, the family lived in Robertsdale, Wood Township, Huntingdon County. At the time Joseph was a coal miner.⁶

By 1910 and 1920 Joseph and Lillie M. family lived in Lack Township, Juniata County, Pennsylvania. Joseph worked as a farm laborer.

In September 1918, 38-year-old Joseph signed up for the WWI draft. At the time he and his wife, Lillie May, lived in Three Springs, Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania. He worked as a laborer for the Mount Union Refractory Company.ⁱⁱⁱ Joseph had a medium build, dark hair and blue eyes.⁷

By 1930 the family had moved to Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania, where Joseph worked for a steel mill. Then in 1940 laborer for a Work Progress Administration WPA.

• The renamed in 1939 as the Work Projects Administration. WPA was an American New Deal agency that employed millions of jobseekers (mostly men who were not formally educated) to carry out public works projects, including the construction of public buildings and roads.

Joseph was 46 years old when he died January 21st 1947 of a coronary thrombosis while working at the Lukens Steel Company in Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest at the Fairview Cemetery in Coatesville. ⁸ FAG#: 222534127 ^{iv}

At some point after Joseph died Lillie moved in with her oldest daughter, Grace Vandergriff, at R.D.#2, Honey Brook, West Caln Township, Chester County.

Lillie was 72 years old when she died May 18^{th} 1959 in West Caln Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest at the Fairview Cemetery in Coatesville. Grace Vandergriff was the informant on Lillie's death certificate. ⁹ FAG#: 222534197 ^v

Joseph and Lillie had these children. In the 1910 census record, Lillie indicated she had three children, and only two were still living.

Grace Gazildia Culbertson (1906–2000)

Grace Gazildia Culbertson was born in December 22nd 1906¹¹ to Joseph Samuel Culbertson and Lillie May Chestnut in Robertsdale, Wood Township, Huntingdon Juniata County, Pennsylvania.¹²

• The name Gazildia comes from her mother's, mother's, maiden name: Gazildia Wilson.

Grace lived with her parents in 1910 and 1920. By 1930 and 1940, when she would have been 26 and 36 years old, she could not be found.

Grace was 42 years old when she married 47-year-old Joseph F. Vandergriff on August 8th 1948 in Honey Brook, Chester County, Pennsylvania. ¹³ Joseph was previously married to Emma Rappold. ¹⁴

By 1950 Joseph and Grace lived in Coatesville, West Caln, Chester County. Living with them were 21-year-old Andrew Vandegriff, 15-year-old Charles Vandegriff, 14-year-old Mary Vandegriff, 11-year-old Carloline Vandegriff, 23-year-old son-in-law Ralph Showalter, and 18-year-old daughter, Margaret Showalter.

Joseph was 53 years old when he died in 1955. He was laid to rest in the Fairview Cemetery Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania. ¹⁵ FAG#: 159365368 ^{viii}

In 1959 Grace was the informant on her mother's death certificate. She lived at R.D.#2, Honey Brook, West Caln Township, Chester County.

After Joseph died Grace married J. Ira "Shorty" Hershey. In 1969, when her step-son Joseph Vandgriff II died, Grace was living in Hershey. ¹⁶

Eventually Grace Hershey, moved to Morgantown, Berks County, Pennsylvania. She was 93 years old when she died in September 7th 2000. ¹⁷She was laid to rest at the Fairview Cemetery, Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania. FAG#: 159365509 ^{ix}

Grace and Joseph did not have children.¹⁸

Orris Samuel Culbertson (1909–1978)

Orris Samuel Culbertson was born September 1st 1909 to Joseph Samuel Culbertson and Lillie May Chestnut in Lack Township, Juniata County, Pennsylvania.¹⁹

Orris lived in the Waterloo area of Junita County until his parents moved to Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania.

In 1929 Harrisburg police believe they apprehended a gang of robbers responsible for the thefts totaling \$4,000 from utility companies and junk dealers throughout Southeastern Pennsylvania with the arrest of Oscar Wolf, 28, of Harrisburg, and Orris Culbertson, 20, of 27 Summit Street, Jason Baxter and Herbert Wolfe, both of 108 High Street, all of Coatesville. They were being held on charges of larceny and felonious entry. Police say the men cut up their loot and sold it to junk dealers in York.²⁰

Then on one day in the 1st week of May 1933 Orris was hitch hiking with a companion from Coatesville, Chester County to his family in Juniata. While on the William Penn highway near Mexico, Juniata County, he was struck by a moving van from New Jersey. Orris was taken to the office of Dr. W. H. Banks in Mifflintown who dressed his wounds. After he was taken to his sister's home, Mrs. Ray Campbell of Cross Keys.²¹

Orris married Helen Luella Showalter²² about 1934 in Juanita County, Pennsylvania. Helen was born October 2nd 1917 in East Waterford, Juniata County, Pennsylvania.

In late April, early May, Orris and Helen Burge applied for, and were granted, a marriage license in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.²³

Helen died August 18th 1970 in Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania.

Orris died June 20th 1978 Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania.
