## Peter Greenawalt (1808 – 1871)

Peter Greenawalt was born January 16<sup>th</sup> 1808 <sup>1</sup> to Nicholas Greenawalt and Mary Miller in Franklin County Pennsylvania. He worked and lived in Orrstown and Culbertson in Green, Letterkenny, and Southampton Townships Franklin County. Peter married Sarah Cover who was born April 4<sup>th</sup> 1809 in Franklin County.

Peter died June 9<sup>th</sup> 1871 while living in Culberton Letterkenny Township Franklin County Pennsylvania; 61 years, 5 months. Sara died June on October 24<sup>th</sup> 1884; 75years, 6moths, 2 days. They are buried at the Kryder Cemetery, next to the Air Hill Brethren in Christ Church and Cemetery, Green Township, Rt 997 and Smith Road, near the back entrance of the Letterkeeny Depot, Franklin County Pennsylvania. Sarah's grave stone cannot be located. One researcher had Peter dying when he was 61 years and 5months, and Sarah at 75 years, 6 months, and 2 days when she died. This cannot be accurate for Peter.

Together they had ten children who were all born in Franklin County Pennsylvania. <sup>2</sup>

- i. Samuel C. Greenawalt was born September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1829 in Southampton Township Franklin County Pennsylvania. He married Margaret Miller on November 2<sup>nd</sup> 1854 in Franklin County Pennsylvania.
- ii. Mary Elizabeth Greenawalt was born March 11<sup>th</sup> 1831. She married George G. Creamer on March14<sup>th</sup> 1850. <sup>4</sup>
- iii. Catherine Greenawalt was born about 1831 or 1833. She married Rummel.<sup>5</sup>
- iv. Nicholas Greenawalt was born August 1<sup>st</sup> 1835. He married Loretta Rummel September 1<sup>st</sup> 1859
- v. Henry Greenawalt was born on August 28<sup>th</sup> 1839 in Green Village Franklin County Pennsylvania. He married Jeanette Brinkley –Louchman on August 13<sup>th</sup> 1864 in Middle Springs Franklin County Pennsylvania, by Daniel Eckerman.
- vi. Annie Greenawalt was reported being a child of Peter and Sara, she was born in 1841. <sup>6</sup> She is not in any census or other record. <sup>7</sup>
- vii. John R Greenawalt was born August 28<sup>th</sup> 1845. He married Catherine Miller.
- viii. Lydia (Lillian) Greenawalt was born 1848 or 1850. She married Benjamin Wingert
- ix. Susan Greenawalt was born 1850. She was not in the 1850 census, she was 10 years old in the 1860 census, and was not in the 1870 census record. 8
- x. Simon Peter Greenawalt was born December 25<sup>th</sup> 1854. He married Ella R. Newman who was born December 9<sup>th</sup> 1854.
