

Sarah Catherine Greenawalt (1865-1946)

Sarah Catherine Greenawalt was born May 6th 1865 to Henry Greenawalt and Jennette Louchmanⁱ in Mongul Southampton Township Franklin County Pennsylvania.¹ She went by the name Sadie.²

- Sadie's death certificate indicated her mother's name was Jenette Brinkley and she was born in Orrstown. Her father was born in Shippensburg. Her grave headstone has the name Jennette Brinley.
- Not sure about the name Brinkley, which is also on Jennette's grave headstone. However, Jennette Louchman is from Henry's Civil War pension file,³ and the name Lochlin comes from Henry's and Jennette's 1864 marriage certificate.⁴

Sadie lived with her parents. About 1888 Sadie had a relationship with a gentlemen named Hostetter. Together they had a son who was born in the spring of 1889.

According to the June 19th 1900 Southampton Township Federal Census for Franklin County Pennsylvania, Sadie was living with her parents Henry and Jeanette. The child's name was listed as Brinton E. Hostetter. The 1910 census record list Brinton as Brinton Greenawalt, and in the 1930 census for Southampton Township Franklin County Pennsylvania Sadie indicated her 1st Marriage was at age 30; about 1895/96.

In June 1901 Sadie had a child, Dora Alice Graham. Then on October 16th 1901 Sadie married William Culbertson-Graham (1873-1948).⁵

Sadie was 81 years old when she died June 14th 1946, and is buried with her Graham family at the Lurgan Cemetery, Lurgan Township Franklin County, Pennsylvania. The informant on Sadie's death certificate was her husband, William Graham, of Lurgan.⁶ FAG#: 95735345ⁱⁱ

Sadie's obituary indicated she passed away at 9 o'clock Thursday morning on June 13th 1946 in her home at Mongul Southampton Township Pennsylvania. Both William's and Sadie's obituaries didn't provide any more information from what we already knew about them.

- i. Earl Brinton Greenawalt was born May 14th 1889 in Mongul Southampton Township Franklin County, Pennsylvania.

Earl Britton Hostetter-Greenawalt (1889-1966)

Earl Brinton Hostetter was born May 14th 1889 to Sadie Greenawalt and Mr. Hostetter in Mongul Southampton Township Franklin County Pennsylvania. Earl went by the name Brinton Greenawalt.

In the June 19th 1900 Southampton Township Federal Census for Franklin County Pennsylvania, Earl was named Brinton E. Hostetter.

According to the April 28th, 1910 Southampton Township Cumberland County Brinton E. Greenawalt, age 20, is working as a hired hand for Adam Wadel and wife, who are both 22 years old.

Briton's marriage application dated 1911 indicated he lived in Moursville-Mowersville PA, and his father was dead at the time the application was being completed. Briton's new wife is Lilly Henry of Shippensburg; her parents were Harvey and Sadie Henry of Shippensburg. At the 1900 census record of Hostetter may be the correct name. I will continue looking into Sadie's previous relationships, and her whereabouts between 1880 and 1900.

Briton married Lillie May Henry of Mowersville, Lurgan Township Franklin County Pennsylvania on March 8th 1911. Lillie was born February 23rd 1892 to Harry and Sadie Henry of Mowersville. Brinton and Lillie divorced in the early 1930s. Lillie died June 1976 while living with her son in Florida. Brinton and Lillie had one son.

Brinton remarried January 23rd 1933 in Hagerstown Maryland to Perl Ethel Sommers who was born April 10th 1907. Brinton and Pearl had two children. Pearl died January 6th 1997 at 89 years old while living in West Fairview. She was laid to rest next to Brinton at the Rolling Green Cemetery Camp Hill Pennsylvania. ⁷

Brinton was 76 years old when he died in Brevard County Florida January 31st 1966, and was laid to rest in Block D - Plot 0284 of the Rolling Green Cemetery Camp Hill Pennsylvania. ⁸⁻⁹

Fredrick Leland Greenawalt (1912-2009)

Fred Leland Greenawalt was born June 28th 1912 to Britton Greenawalt and Lillie May Henry in Shippensburg Pennsylvania. ¹⁰

Fred married Freda Edith Brightbill who was born May 14th 1914, and died March 28th 1950. Fred and Freda divorced and Freda remarried to Paul.

Fred also remarried October 22nd 1954 in Salisbury Maryland Martha Adeline Gillums who was born December 19th 1905. Fred worked as the Director of Planning and Programming, Defense Logistics Agency, Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania. After Fred retired, he and his family moved to Melbourne Florida in 1971.

Fred moved to Melbourne in Brevard County, Florida in 1971 from Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania. He was a retired Director of Planning & Programming for the Defense Supply Agency, Mechanicsburg Naval Depot in Mechanicsburg. He enjoyed the Good Sam's Club and camping.
