4.3 Samuel Wilson Greenawalt (*Unknown German Parent*, *Nichalos-1*, *Peter-2*, *Henry-3*) Samuel was February 14th 1869 (the 1900 census indicated 1870). He married Lillie Myrtle Kohler December 14th 1893. Lillie was born February 1872. Samuel died May 19th 1951

During the late 19th century and early 20th century Samuel worked as a Railroad (Locomotive) Fireman. In 1900 he was living with his brother Thomas at 171 Vernon Street in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Samuel was also recorded as living with his family in Shippensburg at 542 East Garfield Street. No doubt Samuel lived at both places as he worked on the railroad line between Shippensburg and Harrisburg. His brother Thomas also worked for the railroad as a railroad conductor. This helps explain some things about how two known family member's, Pearl Greenawalt-Hoffman's son and my grandfather Calvin Graham, used the railroad in the 1920's to get from Shippensburg to Harrisburg.
