

Introduction

I began this research paper based on the marriage between my great uncle Clyde Wrightstone, ¹ and Hazel I. Moyer. Hazel's parents were William Augustus Moyer and Mary McCartney. ²

We have positively identified the 1st known Pennsylvania Moyer family as John Moyer and Barbara Ebersole.

Often times in our research, the last name was read as Myers, where the digital optical character reader software did not pick up the letter "o" in the name.

We located two John and Barbara Moyer families; one family would be too old to be the parents of our Eli Moyer (1847-1934). At this time I cannot assess what, if any, is the relationship between these two John and Barbara Moyer families are. They may be father and name sake son, who both married women named Barbara.

Many of the Moyer family members attended the Salem Church, known today as Hope Methodist Church, located at 220 Carlisle Pike, Mechanicsburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania 17050. This is also where many family member's were laid to rest.

John Moyer (1793-1857)

John Moyer was born January 26th 1793 ³ in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He married Barbara, who was born July 9th 1792 ⁴ in Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

The families were farmers and lived in the Linglestown area of Lower Paxton Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

In 1860 Barbara lived with her daughter, Mary Moyer-Care in Lower Paxton Township, post office area of Harrisburg.

John died October 17th 1857, and Barbara died February 17th 1874. They were both laid to rest at the Willow Grove Cemetery in Linglestown, Lower Paxton Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania ⁵

John and Barbara had children; from the 1850-1870 census records.

- i. Cornelius Moyer was born about 1827 and lived with the family in 1850.
- ii. William Moyer was born about 1834 and lived with the family in 1850.
- iii. Mary P. Moyer was born April 30th 1836. She married Clement Care, and they lived in Lower Paxton Township, post office area of Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Clement died before 1910. Mary was 78 years old when she died September 30th 1914. She was laid to rest October 3rd 1914 ⁶ near her parents in the Willow Grove Cemetery in Linglestown, Dauphin County Pennsylvania ⁷ R. S. Care was the informant on her death certificate.

John Moyer (1816-1901)

John Moyer was born April 3rd 1816⁸ in Dauphin Countyⁱ Pennsylvania. He married Barbara Ebersole about 1838. Barbara was born September 7th 1811,⁹ also in Dauphin County.¹⁰

In 1860 the family named was listed as Myers,ⁱⁱ and the family lived in Susquehanna Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

My 1870 the family name was still listed as Myers, and the family had moved to Silver Springs Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Living with the family was 12 year old William Chronicle.

In 1880 John and Barbara were living in Hampton Townshipⁱⁱⁱ Cumberland County Pennsylvania. A 16 year old grandson, Francis Moyer (b.1864), was living with the family, and a 26 year old Mary May (b. 1854).

Barbara was 80 years, 1 month, and 5 days old when she died October 12th 1891. She was laid to rest in the Salem Church Cemetery.¹¹ FAG 142820050

In 1900 John was living at 20 West Factory Street in Mechanicsburg Cumberland County with his daughter, Mary. Next door was his son Henry Moyer and his wife Sarah.

John was 85 years, 8 months, 22 days old when he died September 25th 1901. He was laid to rest with his wife at the Salem Church Cemetery.¹² FAG 142819959^{iv}

John and Barbara had eight children.

- i. Aaron E. Moyer was born June 21st 1837, most likely in Lower Paxton Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He was a carpenter, and he was a private in Company B of the 201st Pennsylvania Regiment.

Aaron's wife was Catherine J. Loxley, who was born December 23rd 1838. She died April 12th 1912, and was laid to rest in the Salem Church Cemetery.^v

Aaron was 82 years old when he died February 17th 1920 in Silver Springs Cumberland County Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest February 21st 1920 at the Salem Church Cemetery. George G. Moyer was the informant on his death certificate.¹³ FAG 96953270

Their son was John H. Moyer who was born August 23rd 1862. He died January 2nd 1884, and was laid to rest in the Salem Church Cemetery. ¹⁴

- ii. Henry C. Moyer was born October 22nd 1838, most likely in Lower Paxton Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He was a millwright. He and his wife Sarah lived in Mechanicsburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Sarah was born September 1839 in Pennsylvania. Henry was still married when he died at the age of 81, on April 2nd 1920. He was laid to rest July 7th 1920 in the Mechanicsburg Cemetery. S. H. Moyer was the informant on his death certificate. ¹⁵
- iii. Mary E. Moyer was born December 21st 1840. She lived with the family in 1870 and in 1900. She never married, and died February 23rd 1904. Mary was laid to rest at the Salem Church Cemetery. ¹⁶
- iv. John Moyer was born in 1841. He was 19 years old in 1860, living with the family.
- v. Augustus Moyer was born July 11th 1846. He lived with the family in 1870 and 1880 he lived with the family. He was not married, and at 39 years, 1 month, 9 days old, he died August 20th 1885. He was laid to rest at the Salem Church Cemetery. ¹⁷
- vi. Elias (Eli) Moyer (1847-1934). He lived with the family in 1870.
- vii. Barbara Moyer was born September 2nd 1849. She was 19 years old in 1860, living with the family. She was 16 years, 0 months, 27 days old when she died September 29th 1865. She was laid to rest at the Salem Church Cemetery ¹⁸
- viii. Ann Moyer was born 1852. She lived with the family in 1870.

Eli (Elias) Moyer (1847-1934)

Eli Moyer was born April 19th 1847 to John Moyer and Barbara Ebersole in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. ¹⁹

Eli lived with his parents until he married Catherine (Kate) Kepford about 1871. Kate was born June 9th 1847 to Fred Kepford and Mary Myers in Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Fred and Mary were both born in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. ²⁰

In 1880 the family lived in Upper Allen Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania.

By 1900 the family lived in Silver Springs Township, and later in 1930 at his sister's home on 30 West Green Street in the 4th Ward of Mechanicsburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Sometime after 1930 Eli and his wife went to live with their son, John S. Moyer in Marysville Perry County Pennsylvania.

Eli was 87 when he died August 22nd 1934 while living in Marysville Perry County Pennsylvania. His son John S. Moyer was the informant on Eli's death certificate. Eli was laid to rest August 25th 1934 in the Salem Church Cemetery, ^{vi} Cumberland County Pennsylvania. ²¹ FAG 96894089 ^{vii}

Catherine was 87 years old when she died December 28th 1934 while living in Marysville Perry County Pennsylvania. Her son John Moyer was the informant on her death certificate. Catherine was laid to rest December 31st 1934 in the Salem Church Cemetery, ^{viii} Cumberland County Pennsylvania. ²² FAG 96893937

In 1900 Catherine indicated she had fourteen children and nine were still living.

- i. Mary E. Moyer was born June 10th 1870, and was 2 years, 9 months, 17 days old when she died March 27th 1873. She was laid to rest at the Salem Church Cemetery. ²³
- ii. Barbara Moyer was born 1872. She married 28 year old Robert P. (Parks) Sponsler on February 11th 1897 in Carlisle Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Robert was born 1869 to J. S. and Annie Sponsler. ²⁴ When her brother William died in 1942, Barabra and her husband Parks lived in Shepherdstown Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. ²⁵
- iii. Martha Moyer was born 1874. She married Oliver M. Sipe on December 24th 1893 in Camp Hill Pennsylvania. Oliver was born to Robert H. and Harriet W. Sipe. ²⁶ When her brother William died in 1942, Martha lived in Shepherdstown Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. ²⁷
- iv. Bertha E. Moyer was born 1875. She married 29 year old Charles H. James on January 16th 1896 in New Cumberland York County Pennsylvania. Charles was born 1867 to William and Catherine James. ²⁸ When her brother William died in 1942, Annie lived in New Cumberland York County, Pennsylvania. ²⁹
- v. William Augustus Moyer (1877-1942). He married Mary McCartney
- vi. Alice Moyer was born December 1878. Alice married Mr. Billman about 1899. In 1930 Alice was a widow living with her brother in Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. Also living with her was her son, Kenneth L who was born about 1912 in Pennsylvania, and her daughter Florence L. who was born about 1916 in Pennsylvania.
- vii. Annie was born 1879. She married William McCartney October 19th 1899 in Camp Hill Cumberland County Pennsylvania. William was born 1876 to Jerry McCartney and Mary Kauffman. William is the brother of Mary McCartney, who married Annie's brother, William Augusts Moyer. ³⁰ When her brother William died in 1942, Annie lived in New Kingston Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. ³¹
- viii. Ida A. Moyer was born March 1881.
- ix. Unnamed Male Moyer was born March 1882, and died April 21st 1882. He was laid to rest at the Salem Church Cemetery. ³²

- x. Eli Moyer Jr. was born March 10th 1884 in Cumberland County Pennsylvania.³³ He was 32 years old when he married Maude Lola Auker March 22nd 1922 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Maude was born 1891 to David Auker and Ida Rumbaugh.³⁴ Eli registered for the WWI.³⁵ When his brother William died in 1942, Eli was living in Bryn Mawr, which is located in Radnor Township, Delaware County, Pennsylvania.³⁶
- xi. John G. Moyer was born April 1889. He was 18 years old when he married Emma C. King June 17th 1915 in Mechanicsburg Cumberland County. Emma was born 1897 to James C. King and Harriet E. Fehl.³⁷ When his brother William died in 1942, John was living in Marysville Perry County, Pennsylvania.³⁸
- xii. Daniel M. Moyer was born July 1893. He was 28 years old when he married Grace V. Foltz in New Kingston Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Grace was born 1900 to James Foltz and Clara Bardall.³⁹

William Augustus Moyer (1877-1942)

William A. Moyer was born March 28th 1877 to Eli Moyer and Catherine (Kate) Kepford in Silver Springs Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania.⁴⁰

William was 23 years old when he married Mary L. McCartney November 29th 1900 in Shiremanstown Cumberland County.⁴¹ Mary was born May 15th 1881 to Jerriah (Jerry) McCartney and Mary Kauffman.⁴² Her brother William McCartney married William's younger sister, Annie Moyer. The family believes Glenn Moyer is also her nephew. .

In 1900 the McCartney and Moyer families lived a few homes away from each other in Hogestown area of Silver Springs Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania. The families were farmers, and at times were renters, and property owners. William was a supervisor of a road crew for the State Highway Department. The family also attended the New Kingston Evangelical Church.⁴³

William was 65 years old when he died September 28th 1942 at his home in Hogestown, where services for him were also held. He was laid to rest October 1st 1942 in the Stone Church Cemetery, Section A - Lot 396 - Grave 5, located in Silver Springs Township,^{ix} Pennsylvania.⁴⁴ FAG 77233516

Mary continued to live at 111 East Portland Street in Mechanicsburg, when she was moved to the Harrisburg State Hospital, where she was being treated for organic brain disease. While at the hospital, at the age of 69 years old, Mary died from complications with arteriosclerosis on June 4th 1950. She was laid to rest June 7th 1950, next to her husband in Section A - Lot 396 - Grave 4 (FAG 77233493), in the Stone Church Cemetery.⁴⁵

- ii. Helen M. Moyer was born 1914. She married Merle Weber Januarys 29th 1934 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Merle was born about 1913 to Galen and Lottie May Weber. ⁴⁶
- iii. Hazel I. Moyer was born August 4th 1918. She married Clyde Wrightstone. ⁴⁷
