The Sollenberger Tree

The founder of the American branch of this family came from western part of Germany at an early day and four brothers settled in Lancaster county, Pennsylvania. John Sollenberger, a son of one of these brothers, was born in that county July 23, 1771. His wife was Barbara Yockey. She died December 25, 1836, aged 61 years. He subsequently married Mrs. Catherine (Kline) Hartman, who lived until May 15, 1874. In 1794 he bought two adjoining farms in what is now Monroe township, four miles east of Carlisle, Cumberland County, Pa., where he moved the following spring and lived there sixty years.

One of the farms has been in the Sollenberger name ever since. It is owned by George A. Sollenberger of Carlisle, a great grandson. A stone in the gable of a well preserved barn indicates it was built in 1816.

John Sollenberger died in 1855, aged 84 years. There were no children with the second marriage. There were ten children by the first union. John and Michael were born in Lancaster county and the rest at the homestead in Monroe township, Cumberland county.

They all married and had children. They were members of the Church of the Brethren and most of the descendents cling to that faith today.

JOHN SOLLENBERGER, the oldest child, was born in Lancaster county September 10, 1793, and went with his parents to Cumberland county in 1795. March 26, 1818, he married Hettie Howard Scott of Franklin county, daughter of William and Hannah Howard Scott. The ceremony was performed in Chambersburg by Rev. J. M. Meller, pastor of the Evangelical Lutheran church. He was engaged in agricultural pursuits all his life and in 1856 bought the farms of his father in Monroe township, where he died in July, 1878, at the age of 84. His wife, Hettie Scott, was born December 22, 1797, and died in September, 1868, aged 71 years. To them six children were born, namely:

ANNIE was born in 1819. She became an invalid early in life and was bedfast for over a quarter of a century. She died in 1858, aged 39 years.

CATHERINE was born in 1821 and never married. She died at the home of her nephew, George Addison Sollenberger, in 1899, aged 79 years.

ABRAM was born October 23, 1824, and died November 15, 1897, aged 73 years. He married Annie Mary Seidle, who was born February 2, 1829, and died October 21, 1905, aged 76 years. He had one son—William Harry—born March 11, 1858, who died November 15, 1863, aged five years. In 1875 they adopted a friendless little girl and named her Annie May. She married Orrie R. Ritter and they reside in Mechanicsburg,

Pa. They have two children—Paul Eugene, November 3, 1899, and William Ray, March 10, 1908.

JOHN SOLLENBERGER was born March 7, 1827, and died April 21, 1905, aged 78 years. He married Elizabeth Boozer. She was born July 21, 1825, and died March 4, 1889, aged 64 years. They had the following children:

SAMUEL SCOTT SOLLENBERGER was born March 6, 1830, and died at Newville, Pa., December 17, 1873, aged 43 years. He married Mary Ann Lehn. To them one son was born, David Lehn Sollenberger. Mary Ann Lehn was born September 23, 1830, and died at the home of her son in Shamokin, May 1, 1904, aged nearly 74.

DAVID LEHN SOLLENBERGER was born October 14, 1853. He learned the trade of printing at Newville, Pa., 1869-1872, and has been connected with the newspaper business ever since. He worked at the trade in Pittsburgh, 1873-1877. November 29, 1876, he married Annie A. Brown of Newville. She was born May 26,

1852, and died January 6, 1918, aged nearly 65 years. In 1877 they came to Northumberland county and lived in Shamokin since 1880. David L. Sollenberger was appointed postmaster of Shamokin by President Cleveland August 24, 1894, and served until April 1, 1899. They had the following children:
