## Russell Guy Wrightstone (1893 - 1969)

Russell Guy Wrightstone was born March 8<sup>th</sup> 1893 in to Jonathan Wrightstone and Sarah Fortney in Siddonsburg, Monaghan Township York County Pennsylvania. <sup>1</sup> Russell attended school until the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

Russell married Anna G. Cookerly in 1915. Anna was born in 1892 to Fred C. and Emma Jane Cookerly of New Cumberland Pennsylvania. In 1920 Russell and Bertha lived with Anna's mother, Emma Stahl-Cookerly, <sup>2</sup>at 219 North Street New Cumberland, while Russell worked as a machinist for the rail road.

Since the mid 1917 and into the mid 1930s, Russell was a machinist for the railroad, even while he was a major league baseball player. He stood 5' 10.5", weighing 176 lbs, and was a valuable utility man who played all over the infield and outfield. He made his debut on April 19<sup>th</sup> 1920 with the Philadelphia Phillies, where he was a versatile and hard-hitting, plugging any gap on the field. Russell batted .300 five times, and was often used as a left-handed pinch hitter.

On May 29<sup>th</sup> 1928 the Philadelphia Phillies traded Russ to the New York Giants for Art Jahn. Russ's final game was September 29<sup>th</sup> 1928 with the New York Giants. In 2,992 plate appearances he batted .297 with 60 home runs and 425 runs batted in. His best season was 1925, when he hit .346 with a career-high 14 home runs in just 92 games. Most memorable was the game of May 5, when he smacked two home runs and drove in five runs against the Giants. <sup>3</sup>

By 1930 Russell lived at 643 3<sup>rd</sup> Street in Lemoyne, and continued to work for the railroad as a machinist. In 1940 Russell and his family lived at 504 South 3<sup>rd</sup> Street in Lemoyne. Living with him and his family was his mother-in-law, Emma Cookerly. By this time Russell was working as a manager for the local Hardware store.

Russell was 79 years old when he died February 25<sup>th</sup> 1969 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He and his wife were laid to rest in the Woodlawn Memorial Cemetery in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania.<sup>4</sup>

Russell and Bertha had two children.

- i. Betty J. Wrightstone was born 1911. Betty was 22 years old when she married 21 year old Frederick Clesson Corby Jr. On May 24<sup>th</sup> 1943 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Frederick was born 1922 to Frederick Clesson Corby and Margaret Salisbury.<sup>5</sup>
- Robert G. Wrightstone was born March 5<sup>th</sup> 1927. Robert was 21 years old when he married 19 year old Mary Jane Byerly on August 31<sup>st</sup> 1948 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Mary was born 1929 to Benjamin J. Byerly and Muriel Rhemn.<sup>6</sup>

In 1981 Robert lived at 1509 Carlisle Road in Camp Hill Cumberland County Pennsylvania. He died June 1981. His child was Robert G. Wrightstone Jr. who was born June 13<sup>th</sup> 1950 and lived at 125 Willow Road Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

• A valuable utility man who played all over the infield and outfield, Russ Wrightstone spent all but his last 30 games in the majors with the Philadelphia Phillies. He was 27 years old by the time he reached the majors, and played more third base than any other position. He hit .305 in 1922, the first of five seasons he hit over .300. His best season was 1925, when he hit .346 with a career-high 14 home runs in just 92 games. Most memorable was the game of May 5, when he smacked two home runs and drove in five runs against the Giants. Playing more second base and first base later in his career, he had his last .300 season in 1927, batting .306 with 75 RBI, his peak total. His career average was .297 with 889 hits.
