To the Honorable the Judges of the Orphans
Court of York County:

I, the undersigned administrator of
Elenora Einsig late of Springgarden Township
in said County deceased, to the petition of
Frederick Meyers dated the 10th day of May
AD 1880, praying that a citation may issue
to the said administrator, and heirs at law
of the said Elenora Einsig dec^d, commanding
them to appear in Court on the 24th day of
May AD 1880, and show cause if any
they have, why a specific performance should
not be decreed of a contract in writing for
the sale by the said Elenora Einsig to the said
Frederick Meyers of a piece or parcel of land
in said Springgarden Township.

Answer: That a contract in writing
was entered into by the said Elenora Einsig
and Frederick Meyers on the 14th day of De-
cember AD 1875, as mentioned in the peti-
tion of the said Frederick Meyers for the
sale of a piece or parcel of land with
a two story frame house thereon erected
situate on Ridge Avenue in said Township,
as more specifically set forth and described
in the petition of the said Frederick Meyers
for the consideration of seven hundred
dollars, payable in the manner set forth
in the said petition of said Meyers. That the

law bargained for is that set forth and described in the petition of the said Myers. That the said Frederick Myers paid to the said Elenora Cusig in her lifetime in pursuance of said contract the sum of \$465, and there yet remains unpaid of said purchase money \$235. That the said Elenora Cusig died before the last payments under said written contract became payable, and that the said Frederick Myers since the death of the said Elenora Cusig has tendered to the undersigned as administrator of said decedent the unpaid portion of the consideration money mentioned in said written contract, viz \$235. That no deed was executed and delivered by the said Elenora Cusig in her lifetime for the said premises, and that I as administrator of said Elenora Cusig decd. admit the truth of the facts in the petition of the said Frederick Myers set forth, and submit the matter to the adjudication and decree of the said Court, according to equity, and the laws of this Commonwealth made and provided
