The Grand Inquest of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, inquiring for the County of York, upon their respective oaths and affirmations, do present, That

— Leo Myers —

late of the said County *Yeoman* on the *Tenth* day of
January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
at the County aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with force and arms, &c., did
commit the crime of adultery with one
Katie Einzig, by then and there having un-
lawful carnal knowledge of the body of
her the said Katie Einzig; he the said Leo
Myers, being then and there a married man,
having a lawful wife in full life on the
day and year aforesaid, to wit: one Cath-
arine Myers; and she the said Katie
Einzig, not being then and there his wife;
Contrary to the form of the Act of the
General Assembly in such case made
and provided, and against the peace
and dignity of the Commonwealth of
Pennsylvania.
