

Anthony Andrew Einsig (1869-1945)

Anthony Andrew ¹ Einzig was born March 17th 1869 ⁱ to John George Einsig and Teresa Berger ² in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. Anthony went by the name Andrew.

Andrew was 23 years old when he applied for a marriage license with 20 year old Ella N. New on May 7th 1889 in York Pennsylvania. At that time Andrew indicated he was a basket maker. ³ Ella was born February 25th 1869 to Adam New and Mary Smith in Ohio. ⁴

In 1900 Andrew was still married and living with his parents, and his brother John Jr., who was also married, at 26 Sherman Street in York Pennsylvania. Andrew's wife Ella was living with her mother, Mary New, at 598 East King Street in York. Ella continued to live with her mother and by 1910 she and her mother, and Ella's son James A., lived at the rear of 514 East King Street. Andrew was living a few blocks east with his father at 204 South Sherman Street ⁱ in York.

- Mary Smith married Adam New and they lived at 215 South Stanley Street in York Pennsylvania. Mary was born Jun 1835 ⁵ to Francis Smith in Germany. Mary died February 10th 1913 in York Pennsylvania. Mary was laid to rest February 13th at the Mount Rose cemetery in York. Mrs. Frank Snyder was the informant on Mary's death certificate. ⁶

In 1910 Andrew worked as a machine hand with a furniture foundry. Andrew's father died in 1915, and Andrew purchased the home on Sherman Street, and by 1920 Andrew and Ella, with their son James A., were back living together. Andrew continued to work as a laborer for the furniture factory.

In 1930 Andrew and his wife were still living on Sherman Street, along with their son Andrew J. Einsig. This is the first time we see a son Andrew, who was born about 1901. Andrew as mentioned as an uncle when his nephew Adam Myers died in 1939. ⁷

Andrew and Ella continued to live at 204 South Sherman Street in York, when at 76 years old, he died on December 6th 1945. He was laid to rest December 10th 1945 at the Mt. Rose cemetery in Spring Garden Township York Pennsylvania. His son Andrew J. Einsig was the informant on Andrew's death certificate. ⁸ FAG#:99241402 ⁱⁱ

Ella was 85 years old when she died at her home on Sherman Street on October 27th 1954. Her son Andrew J. Einsig was the informant on Andrew's death certificate. ⁹ FAG#:153939997 ⁱⁱⁱ

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In 1910 Ella indicated she had only one child who was still living.

- i. Andrew James Einsig was born May 17th 1901 in York Pennsylvania. ¹⁰

Andrew went by the name James when he lived with his mother and grandmother in 1910 and 1920. In 1930 his name was Andrew J, and he was a laborer in a junk yard, which is the same profession as his cousins.

Andrew married Agnes A. Hoskins, who was born in 1913 to William Hoskins and Bertha Bollinger in York Pennsylvania. ¹¹

- Agnes had the following siblings in 1975: Edward, Charles and Robert Hoskin, and Edith Strasbaugh, all of York.

The 1940 federal census record recorded James A. Einsig, his wife Agnes A., and daughter Shirley M. living at 51 South Tremont Street in York Pennsylvania. James was a laborer in an Auto grave (junk) yard.

Andrew was 65 years old when he died June 1966 in York, ¹² and was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. ^{iv} FAG#:154375151

Agnes was 62 years old when she died Friday January 31st 1975, at 4:30 a.m., at Memorial Osteopathic Hospital in York Pennsylvania. The Rev. Preston Haugh, pastor of Zion United Methodist Church on East Prospect officiated services Monday at 10 a.m. at the Sleeper Funeral Home in York. Agnes was laid to rest at Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. ¹³
