

David J. Einsig (1873-1923)

David J.ⁱ Einsig was born in 1873 to George Einsig and Barbara Gehring¹ in Freystownⁱⁱ Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania.² David lived with his parents at the home of his grandmother, Elenora Einsig, on Ridge Avenue in Freystown.

Then in 1877 David's mother took her children to live with her parent's in the old neighborhood of Bull Frog Alley in Freystown. After David's mother was murdered by his father,³ David and his siblings continued to live with their grandparents, Andrew and Mary Gehring.

David applied for his marriage license and married Mary Ellen Keller on June 2nd 1893 in York Pennsylvania.⁴ Mary Ellen Keller was born February 14th 1876 to Jacob Keller and Josephine Smith in York County Pennsylvania.⁵ Mary went by the name Ellen or Ella.

David and his family lived at 740 King Street in York Pennsylvania, where he was in the junk business.

David was 50 years old when he died May 21st 1923 at the Almshouse in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest on May 28th at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Township in York. The superintendent at the almshouse was the informant on David's death certificate.⁶ FAG#:157930703ⁱⁱⁱ

By 1930 Ella was living with Michael, Josephine, Frank, and Arthur at 722 East King Street in York Pennsylvania.

Mary never remarried, and she lived with her son George and his wife, Jennie, at 668 East Market Street in York. Mary was 79 years old when she died at home on May 22nd 1955. She was laid to rest on May 24th at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Township in York. Her daughter-in-law Jennie Einsig was the informant on her death certificate.⁷ FAG#:157930808^{iv}

In 1900 Mary indicated she had five children, and five were still living. In 1910 she indicated she had eight children, and eight were still living. Mary had three more children; having eleven children in all.

Freystown became part of York city around 1900 (sources vary), but not without reluctance.

- iv. Paul Einsig (1899-1936). He married Goldie M. Emswiler.
- v. Grace Einsig was born in 1901 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. She married Mr. Picking, and when her bother Paul died in 1936, she lived with her husband in York Pennsylvania. ⁸
- vi. Oliver Einsig was born April 5th 1903 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ella Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. ⁹ Oliver never married, and was single living at RD#6 York. He was 52 years old when he died May 30th 1955 in the rural area of Manchester Township, of acute fulminating cellulites of the right arm. Oliver was laid to rest June 2nd at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. George Sleeper of 822 East Market Street York was the informant on Oliver's death certificate. ¹⁰ FAG#:157930937
- vii. David John Einsig (1905-1963). He married Caroline E. Hoerni.
- viii. Michael J. Einsig was born August 28th 1907 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. ¹¹ Michael was still living with his mom in 1930 at 722 East King Street in York Pennsylvania. He enlisted into the Army during WW II on October 19th 1943, and was discharged October 30th 1945. Michael was 87 years old when he died January 15th 1995, and was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill cemetery in York Pennsylvania. ¹² FAG#:157931180
- ix. Frank Einsig was born June 15th 1911 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. ¹³ Frank was still living with her mom in 1930 at 722 East King Street in York Pennsylvania. Frank remained single and was 37 years old when he died July 13th 1948. Frank was laid to rest July 16th at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Township York. His brother Arthur Einsig, of 722 East King Street, was the informant on the data certificate. ¹⁴ FAG#: 157931045
- x. Josephine Einsig (1917-1994). She married James McKinley.
- xi. Arthur Einsig (1920-2009). He married Ruth Piffer.

Mary I. Einsig (1892-1945)

Mary I. Einsig was born August 20th 1892 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. ¹⁵

Mary was pregnant, and just shy of her 20th birthday, when she married Charles Cephus Stottlemeyer ¹⁶ on August 3rd 1912 in York Pennsylvania. ¹⁷ Charles was born January 10th 1889 to William Stottlemeyer and Matilda Patterson ¹⁸ in Steelton Dauphin County Pennsylvania. ¹⁹ Both of his Charles's parents were born in Maryland.

Soon after they married the couple lived at 740 East King Street in York, where their first child was born. By the time Charles signed up for the WW I draft, the family was living 735 Mason Street in York, where Charles was a junk dealer for L. Lipsitz. At the time the couple already had three children under twelve years old. ²⁰ By 1930 the family moved to a home at 471 Chester Place in York, and later to 547 Edgar Street, also in York. Charles was 53 years old when he signed up for the WW II draft. At the time the family lived at 602 Jessup Place in York. He worked Smyser-Royer on North Beaver Street in York. ²¹

Mary lived at 602 Jessup Place in York Pennsylvania when she died at 52 years old on May 9th 1945. She was laid to rest May 12th at the Greenmount Cemetery ^v in York Pennsylvania. Her daughter Dorothy Stottlemeyer, of 603 Jessup Place, was the informant on Mary's death certificate. ²² FAG#:89441084 ^{vi}

Charles went to live with his daughter, Ethel Gatewood, at 233 East Philadelphia Street in York. He was 65 years old when he died March 20th 1954 at the York Hospital in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest on the 24th at the Greenmount Cemetery. Ethel Gatewood, of 233 East Philadelphia Street in York, was the informant on his death certificate. ²³ FAG#:89440963

Charles and Mary Stottlemeyer's children were all born in York, York County Pennsylvania.

- xi. Mary Elizabeth Stottlemyer was born Decemebr 14th 1928. ²⁹ She had a male Stottlemyer child born prematurely on December 17th 1948 with Charles Hoskins, who she later married. The child died December 18th, and was laid to rest on the 22nd at Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. Mary's sister, Dorothy, was the informant on the child's death certificate. ³⁰ FAG#: Mary died September 10th 1991. ³¹
- xii. Ethel Romaine Stottlemyer was born February 20th 1930. She married 1st to Mr. Gatewood, and 2nd to Mr. Tresselt. Ethel died June 18th 1988. ³²
- xiii. Athaleen Stottlemyer was born May 20th 1932. She was eight days shy of her third birthday, when she was hit by a car. She died May 12th 1935 at the York Hospital from a fractured skull, hemorrhaging, and ruptured liver. She was laid to rest on May 14th at the Greenmount Cemetery in York. Her mother, Mary, was the informant on Athaleen's death certificate. ³³ FAG#:

George Steven Einsig (1895-1963)

George Steven Einsig was born August 13th 1895 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. ³⁴ Like his father George worked in the junk business, buying, selling, and trading on junk items.

George was 17 years old when his father, David, gave his consent on October 10th 1912 for George to marry 21 year old Elsie Marie Hauer. On October 10th 1912 the young couple married in York Pennsylvania. ³⁵ Elsie was born November 20th 1892 to Albert Hauer and Mary Munois in York Pennsylvania. ³⁶

Something happened between George and Elsie, and on February 12th 1917 his divorce from Elsie was finalized. A few days later, 21 year old George, married 23 year old Jennie Elizabeth Cole on February 17th 1917 in York Pennsylvania. Jennie was born November 17th 1893 ³⁷ to George Cole and Elizabeth Tracy in Maryland. ³⁸

- Elsie never remarried, and went back to using her maiden name. She would later live with her daughter Mary Rosenweig, working as a seamstress.
- Elsie was 66 years old when she died at the York Hospital on June 5th 1959. She was laid to rest on June 8th in the John and Mary Rosenweig family plot, Mount Zion Cemetery in Springettsbury Township York County Pennsylvania. ^{vii} Her daughter Mrs. John Rosenberg, of 535 Girard Avenue in York, was the informant on Elsie's death certificate. ³⁹ FAG#:111230116 ^{viii}

By 1920 and 1930 George and Jennie lived with Jennie's mother, Elizabeth Tracey, at 716 Market Street in York, where George worked as a laborer in a junk shop. By 1940 George's brother, David, and his wife lived with George and Jennie at 722 East Market Street. At this time George was a janitor for a local church.

George and Jennie eventually came to live at 668 East Market Street in York Pennsylvania. It was at this address when George became ill. He was 67 years old when he died on January 4th 1963 at the York Hospital. He was laid to rest January 7th at the Mt. Rose Cemetery. His wife Jennie E. was the informant on his death certificate. ⁴⁰ FAG#:156548037 ^{ix}

Jennie was 83 years old when she died in February 1983. ⁴¹

George and Jennie did not have any children.

George and his 1st wife Elsie had one child. ⁴²

- i. Mary Catherine Einsig was born in 1913. After her parents divorced, Mary lived with her grandparents, Albert and Mary Haur, in York.

Mary was 20 years old when she applied for her marriage license on December 4th 1934. On December 19th 1934 she married 23year old John Fredrick Rosensweig ⁴³ in York Pennsylvania. ⁴⁴ John was born November 10th 1911 to Edward Rosensweig ^x and Emma Noel in Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. ⁴⁵

After they married the couple lived in York, and by 1950 the couple lived with Mary's mother at 535 Girard Avenue in York, where John was a truck driver.

John was 45 years old when he hung himself, and died on December 23rd 1956. He was laid to rest December 24th at the Rosenweig family plot, Mount Zion Cemetery in Springettsbury Township York County Pennsylvania. His son Edward was the informant on John's death certificate. ⁴⁶

Catherine K. Einsig was born June 25th 1897 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in York Pennsylvania. ⁴⁷ Catherine went by the name Katie.

Catherine was 16 years old when she then married 22 year old Franklin P. Bupp Jr. November 8th 1913 in York Pennsylvania. ⁴⁸ Franklin was born in 1891 to Franklin P. Bupp Sr. and Catherine Rhine in York. ⁴⁹

Katie and Frank lived at 632 King Street in York, where he worked for the New York Wire Cloth Company.

Katie was 59 years old when she died December 20th 1956 at home. She was laid to rest December 23rd at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York. Mrs. J. P. Ledig was the informant. ⁵⁰ FAG#:148084446 ^{xi}

Frank lived at 632 East King Street. He was 79 years old when he died August 13th 1971 at the York Hospital in York. ⁵¹ He was laid to rest with his wife at the Mount Rose Cemetery. FAG#:147241114

Catharine and Frank had these children.

Paul Andrew Einsig (1899-1936)

Paul Andrew Einsig ⁵⁴ was born in February 13th 1899 to David J. Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. ⁵⁵

Paul was 17 years old when he obtained consent to marry on April 4th 1916. On April 25th he married Goldie May Emswiler ⁵⁶ in York Pennsylvania. ⁵⁷ Goldie was born in 1898 to George and Emma.

After they married, the young family moved in with Goldie's parents at 436 Walnut Street in York where Paul was a laborer for a local chain manufacturer. By 1930 the families owned their home at 1224 East Philadelphia Street on York, and Paul was now working for a Wire Cloth Company.

The family eventually came to live at RD#1 Hellem in York County Pennsylvania. Paul was 27 years old when he died November 29th 1936 at his mother's home at 722 East King Street in York. He was laid to rest December 1st at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden York. His wife Goldie, of R.D. #1 Hellem in York County, was the informant on his death certificate. ⁵⁸ FAG#:157931967

Paul and Goldie Einsig's children included

- i. Pauline May Einsig was born March 15th 1917 to Paul Einsig and Goldie Emswiler in York Pennsylvania.⁵⁹ She remained single, and in 1936 lived with her parents in York.

About 1938 she married Edward E. Reigart⁶⁰ of Laurel Maryland. Edward was born January 24th 1914 in Larue in Springfield Township York County Pennsylvania.

Pauline and Edward 1st lived in Lancaster County, and later lived at 909 East Princess Street in York, and by 1943 they moved to 36 North Franklin Street in York Pennsylvania. While living on North Franklin Street, on December 21st 1943, Edward enlisted into the Army in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. On January 11th 1944 Edward began his service, and was discharged December 11th 1945.

In February 1950, when he applied for his WW II compensation, the family lived at R.D. #1 Manchester York County.⁶¹

Pauline and Edward divorced, and in 1965 Pauline worked at Danskin Incorporated, where she retired from in 1985 as a machine operator. She was also a member of Christ Chapel International Ministries.

On August 1st 1968, 51 year old Pauline married 60 year old George Wilbur Kipp in Charlottesville Virginia. George was born September 26th 1907 to Daniel B. Kipp and Sarah Ann Reichard in Laurel Maryland.⁶²

- Edward Reigart died September 19th 1983.⁶³

Pauline was 90 years old when she died Wednesday, November 21st 2007 at the Manor Care Health Services-North in York Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest November 26th at the Mount Rose cemetery in York Pennsylvania.⁶⁴ FAG#:23069729

David John Einsig (1905-1963)

David John Einsig was born June 13th 1905 to David Einsig and Mary Ellen Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania.⁷³

David was 24 years old when her married Caroline Elizabeth Hoerni on September 29th 1928 in York.⁷⁴ Caroline was born September 8th 1909⁷⁵ to John J. Hoerni and Anna Belle Eck in Pennsylvania. Her father was born 1861 in Switzerland, and her mother 1890 in Maryland. John immigrated in 1866 and was naturalized in 1883.

By 1831 the couple moved in with David's mother, Ella, at 722 East King Street in York. By 1940 David and Caroline lived with David's brother, George, at 722 East Market Street in York. At the time David worked as a wire winder for a local wire company.

David was separated from his wife, and had lived at 119 West King Street in York Pennsylvania. He was 57 years old when he died April 3rd 1963 at Pleasant Acres in Springettsbury R.D.#7 in York Pennsylvania. David was laid to rest April 6th at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in York. Mary Reamer of Pleasant Acres was the informant on the death certificate. ⁷⁶ FAG#:157056207

Caroline died July 8th 1993. ⁷⁷ She was laid to rest at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in York. FAG#:158087225

David and Caroline had one child.

- i. Charles David Einsig was born July 2nd 1929 to David John Einsig and Caroline Elizabeth Hoerni in York Pennsylvania. Charles graduated from William Penn Senior High School and was a U.S. Army veteran, having served in the Korean War. He married Thelma M. Tome on October 14th 1950 in York.

Charles worked at Motter Printing Press as a machinist and supervisor, and at Campbell Chain Works as a toolmaker and supervisor. He also worked at R & S MFG. Company in Columbia, and at Harley Davidson Motor Company, from where he retired as a maintenance machinist in the beginning of 2005. He also served as supervisor of Hellam Township for 20 years. Mr. Einsig was a member of St. Paul's (Missouri Synod) Lutheran Church in Columbia. He was also a member of the Pleasureville American Legion, Post 799 and the York County Heritage Trust.

Charles was 76 when he died unexpectedly on Tuesday, October 25th 2005, at 8:55 p.m. at York Hospital. He was laid to rest at the Salem Community Cemetery,^{xii} Martinsville Charge, in Windsor Township York County Pennsylvania. The ceremony included full military rites by the York County Veterans Honor Guard. ⁷⁸ FAG#:157930390

Josephine B. Einsig was born May 24th 1917⁷⁹ to David Einsig and Ella Keller in the East King Street area of York Pennsylvania. Josephine was still living with her mom in 1930 at 722 East King Street in York Pennsylvania.

Josephine married James McKinley⁸⁰ about 1938. James was born in 1913 to Latimer and Grace McKinley. In 1940 the family lived James's parents in Chanceford Township, outside York, in York County Pennsylvania. James worked as a farm laborer.

James died in 1966, and was laid to rest at the Bethel United Methodist Church Cemetery, Shenks Ferry in York County Pennsylvania. FAG#:142499972

Josephine was 77 years old when she died September 1994.⁸¹ She was laid to rest wither husband at the Bethel United Methodist Church Cemetery. FAG#:142499996
