

David Jacob Einzig (1829-1908)

David Jacob Einzigⁱ was born March 15th 1829 to David Einzig¹ and Barbara Rupp² in the village area of Ruestenⁱⁱ located in the Schwarzwald Kreisⁱⁱⁱ of Württemberg^{iv} Germany.³

David was about 13 years old when he arrived at the port of Baltimore with his family on December 22nd 1843.^v Their place of origin was Reusten Germany, and their destination was identified as Pennsylvania.⁴ On September 30th 1851,^{vi} David took the oath of alliance to America, and was naturalized in York County Pennsylvania.⁵

David married Christiana Elizabeth Henrietta Ross about 1848.^{vii} Christiana was born April 6th 1829 to Daniel Ross and Barbara Hild in Dillheim, a municipality in the Rhein-Neckar district of Baden-Württemberg, Germany.⁶ Christiana also went by the name Anna and Annie, and on the 1910 census record she indicated she immigrated to America in 1844.

David was a basket maker, and lived in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania.

- Freystown is part of the Spring Garden Township in York County Pennsylvania. It was a flourishing community with a rich history just east of York City; sitting between Philadelphia and King Streets, extending from Broad Street to Sherman Street. Bull Frog Alley was the low swampy area around Fulton Street. Early settlement centered on what is now East Market Street around Ridge Avenue and Diehl's Mill Road (Sherman Street).⁷

In 1880 Jacob Ross, age 25 born about 1862 in Maryland, lived with the family, and he too was a basket maker. Jacob's mother was born in Bavaria and father in Hesse. He may be a nephew of Christiana.

David was 79 years old when he died July 18th 1908 while living at 747 East King Street in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest July 12th 1908 in the Prospect Hill cemetery in York. His son, John Eizig, was the informant on her death certificate.⁸ FAG#:149310094^{viii}

ⁱ David's middle initial was on many records, including his death certificate. The name Jacob is assumed, and it may also be Johann or John. Other spellings of Einzig include Aensick, Ensick, Einsick, Eimsich, Einig, and Eisig, and the late 19th century version of Einsig. Einzig in German means "only". Other uses include; lone, singly, sole, and unique.

ⁱⁱ The word, Ruesten is a miss spelling of Reusten, located in the Tübingen Region which is within the 19th century administrative district and parish of Schwarzwald Kreis (Black Forest District) of Württemberg Germany.

ⁱⁱⁱ Swarzwald means Black Forest and Kreis means District; in 2015 known as Schwarzwald-Baar-Kreis.

^{iv} Württemberg Germany existed from 1806 to 1918; in 2015 known as Baden-Württemberg.

In 1910 Christiana lived with her daughter Josephine Stroll.

Christiana was 82 years old when she died November 11th 1911 while living in York, York County Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest November 14th 1911 at the Prospect Hill cemetery in York. Her son, John H. Einzig, was the informant on her death certificate. ⁹ FAG#:149310860

We used the 1860 and 1870 census record and the 1900 census record when Christiana (Annie) indicated she had six children, and five were still living. In 1910 Annie indicated she had 1 chld born, and still living. However other records indicate David and Christiana may have had eight children, but we could only identify seven of them. This generation of the Einzig family was fluent in the German language.

- i. Mary Ann Einsig (1851-1888). She married Adam Smith.
- ii. Elenora Einsig (1854-1937). She married Andrew Sharp.
- iii. Josephine Einzig (1857-1942). She married William Storll.
- iv. John H. Einsig (1860-1939), and he married Mary Anna Schleich.

Mary Ann Einsig (1851 - 1888)

Mary Ann Einsig was born 1851 to David Einzig and Christiana Ross in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. She married Adam Smith on February 23rd 1871 at the Christ Lutheran Church in York, York County Pennsylvania. ¹⁰

Adam was born March 1850 to Henry and Mary Smith in Maryland, and both of his parents were born in Hesse Darmstadt Germany. Adam was a basket maker and the family lived in Freystown York County Pennsylvania.

By 1880 the family didn't have any children. Annie died at 7:00 o'clock in the morning, August 29th 1898. ¹¹ Mary, wife of Adam Smith, was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. ¹² FAG#:104174533

- Adam was 48 years old, living at 573 East King Street in York Pennsylvania, when he then married 39 year old Mary Ida Bell-Yeaple on February 21st 1900 in York Pennsylvania.
- Mary Ida Bell was born July 17th 1859 to Adam Bell and Delilah Clapper in York County Pennsylvania. ¹³
- Adam identified his parents as Henry and Mary Smith, and his occupation as a manufacturer. Mary lived at 126 North Water Street in York, and identified her parents as Adam and Delilah Bell.
- Mary was previously married to Edward Yeaple, who was born in Wellsville York County Pennsylvania. ¹⁴ Edward died May 22nd 1899. ¹⁵

In 1900 Adam was still a basket maker, and Mary indicated she did not have any children. However, two children were identified as Adam's children: Robert B. Smith who was born in June 1887, and a daughter Mattie T. Smith who was born June 1890. The family now lived at 573 Pittston and East King Street in York Pennsylvania, beside Adam's father, 82 year old Henry Smith. The children were:

- George B. Yeaple (Robert is an error on the census) was born February 1880 Edward Yeaple and Mary I. Bell in York Pennsylvania. He lived at 152 West Front Street in Marietta Lancaster County Pennsylvania. George was 59 years old, a widower, when he died July 20th 1939 at the Rossmere Sanatorium in Manheim Lancaster County. He was laid to rest July 22nd at the Prospect Hill Cemetery. ¹⁶
- Mattie Taylor Yeaple was born about 1892 to Edward Yeaple and Mary I. Bell in York Pennsylvania. Mary married John Saul and they lived in Manchester Township York County Pennsylvania. Mattie was 36 years old when she died April 15th 1928. She was laid to rest April 19th at the Prospect Hill Cemetery. Her husband, John Saul, was the informant on her death certificate. ¹⁷

Adam lived in Freystown, Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania, when he died May 24th 1904. ¹⁸ His will was dated October 7th 1890, and it was filed on June 22nd 1904 in York County Pennsylvania. Adam left his entire estate to his 2nd wife, Mary, and there was no mention of any children. ¹⁹ FAG#:

- By 1910 Mary and a child Ruth A. Smith, born 1902, lived as a housekeeper for Moses Aubel on Chance Port Pike in York Township York County Pennsylvania. Mary was 59 years old, living at R.F.D. No. 2, York Township, when she died May 4th 1919. She was laid to rest May 7th at the Prospect Hill cemetery York Pennsylvania. Her son George B. Yeaple was the informant on her death certificate. ²⁰

Elenora Einsig (1854-1937)

Elenora Einsig was born September 2nd 1854 to David Einzig and Christiana Ross in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. She went by the name Ellen, and she married Andrew Sharp ²¹ about 1870 in York Pennsylvania. ^{ix}

Andrew Sharp was born July 25th 1849 to George Sharp and Theresa Kahley in Pennsylvania. Both of Andrew's parents were born in Württemberg Germany. ²² According to the 1900 census record Andrew's father was born in Bavaria, and his mother in Württemberg Germany

Andrew was a basket maker, and in 1880 he and Elenora lived on the same Street with other Einsig family members in Freysville, outside York Pennsylvania. Andrew was a basket maker.

In 1900 Elenora, Andrew, and a child named May were living at 587 Rousek Avenue York Pennsylvania. May (Goldie) was identified as their daughter who was born on September 1891.

On April 6th 1906 Elenora's adopted daughter, Goldie Smith, was confirmed and attended her 1st catechism class.

On January 6th 1907 Roy and Elenora renewed their membership with the Emanuel United Church of Christ. All three family members participated in communion ceremonies up until the 4th quarter 1909. ²³

Andrew was 67 years old when he died July 17th 1917. He was laid to rest July 9th at Mount Rose cemetery. His son-in-law, Roy H. Gotwalt, was the informant on the death certificate. ²⁴

After Andrew died Elenora went to live with Goldie Gotwalt and her family on Bolls Avenue York Pennsylvania. Elenora continued to live with Goldie and her husband Roy for until 1937.

Elenora was 82 years old, and a widow living at 532 Ogontz Street in Spring Garden Township York Pennsylvania, when she died July 5th 1937. She was laid to rest July 8th 1937 at the Mt Rose cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Her son-in-law, Roy H. Gotwalt, was the informant on her death certificate. ²⁵

In 1900 Elenora indicated she had one child who was still living. The daughter was adopted by Elenora and Andrew sometime during the late 19th century. Elenora's older sister, Mary Ann, married Adam Smith, and there may be a Smith family relationship, but not directly to Mary Ann and Adam Smith.

- i. Goldie May Smith was born in September 1891 to William and Amelia Smith in York Pennsylvania. On April 6th 1906 Goldie was confirmed and attended her 1st catechism class at the Emanuel United Church of Christ in York Pennsylvania. ²⁶

Goldie married Roy Herbert Gotwalt on February 24th 1912 at the Emanuel United Church of Christ. ²⁷ Roy Herbert Gotwalt was born October 30th 1893 to Daniel Gotwalt and Elizabeth Tyson in York Pennsylvania. ²⁸

On June 5th 1917 Roy signed up for the WW I draft, which indicated a wife and two children. The family lived at R.F.D. #2 in York Township York County Pennsylvania. Roy worked as a machine fixer for the York Knitting Mills Company in York. ²⁹

In 1920 Goldie's mother, Elenora Sharp lived with the family on Bolls Avenue York Pennsylvania. Roy worked as an assembler for a safe company. By 1930 Roy was a machinist at a hosiery factory.

Goldie died 1939, and was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden, York Pennsylvania. FAG#:60727272

In 1940 Roy was still a widower, and living with three of his children. At the time he was a foreman at the hosiery factory. Soon after 1940 Roy married Evelyn E. Myers. Evelyn was born May 13th 1907 to James Myers and Emma Lauber in York Pennsylvania. ³⁰

- Evelyn was previously married to Clarence L. Bosserman, who she had divorced during the early 1930s.
- Clarence L. Bosserman was born to May 14th 1906 to Michael Bosserman and Emma Bollinger in York Pennsylvania. He was 48 years old, living at 20 South College Avenue, when he committed suicide, by hanging on September 23rd 1954. He was laid to rest September 26th at the Mummert's Meeting House in Adams County Pennsylvania. His son, Clarence Bosserman Jr., was the informant on his father's death certificate. ³¹ FAG#:
- In 1930 Evelyn and her husband were not living together. Clarence was living with his parents, Michale and Emma Bosserman at 1157 East King Street York, with his sons Clarence L. Jr.(b.1926) and Charles A. Bosserman)b.1928). Clarence Sr. was a driver of a bakery wagon.
- By 1940 Evelyn was divorced and living by herself in York Pennsylvania.

By April 27th 1942, Roy was 48 years old, married to Evelyn E., and they lived at 900 Hill Street in York. Roy worked for Joseph Black and Son's Company at 1200 West Market Street in York. ³²

Evelyn was a licensed practical nurse at the York Hospital and in private duty. She was a member of St. Rose of Lima Church, the Secular Franciscan Order; and was a Past Regent of Loyal Order of Moose York.³³

Roy was 63 years old and living at R.D. #3 in the York area of Pennsylvania, when he died March 8th 1957 at the York Hospital. He was laid to rest March 21st at the Mount Rose Cemetery. Clarence B. Bosserman (husband of a daughter), of 528 South Queen Street in York, was the informant on Roy's death certificate.³⁴ FAG#:60727198

Roy's 2nd wife, Evelyn E. Gotwalt, was 96 when she died Thursday, January 1st 2004, at Colonial Manor Nursing Center in York Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania.³⁵ FAG#:

- Surviving were two sons, Clarence Bosserman and Charles Bosserman, both of York; a stepson, Marlet Gotwalt of Delaware; two grandsons, Michael Bosserman and Stephen Bosserman; and a granddaughter, Laurie Bosserman.³⁶

Goldie and Roy children included.

- a. Elizabeth E. Gotwalt was born about 1913
- b. Herbert S. Gotwalt was born about 1915
- c. Roy H. Gotwalt was born about August 1917
- d. Frances H. Gotwalt was born May 9th 1920 to Roy Gotwalt and Goldie Sharp in York Pennsylvania. She was 2 years old when she died December 5th 1922 in Freysville Spring Garden Township York Pennsylvania. Francis was laid to rest December 6th at Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Frances's father, Roy H. Gotwalt, was the informant on the death certificate.³⁷ FAG#: 60728348
- e. Eugene W. Gotwalt was born in 1924. With dad in 1940
- f. Male Gotwalt was stillborn to Roy Gotwalt and Goldie Smith on October 15th 1926 in York Pennsylvania. The child was laid to rest October 6th at the Mount Rose Cemetery. The child's father, Roy H. Gotwalt, was the informant on the death certificate.³⁸ FAG#:
- g. Louise M. Gotwalt was born in 1925. With dad in 1940
- h. Marlet L. Gotwalt was born in 1929. He married Delores Chronister in 1948. Marlet also had a nickname of "Dirk".

Marlet was a life member of Bethany United Methodist Church on Mt. Rose Avenue in York. He lived his religious convictions, and was a loving and honorable family man. Dirk grew up in York, and enjoyed sports and sports statistics as a young man while keeping close ties with many of his friends from the Mount Rose neighborhood. He attended monthly lunches with these friends until recently. As a graduate from York High School, he became an avid York High basketball fan and attended as many games as possible. Dirk was a passionate golfer, and had been seen at the old Yorktowne GC in the midst of winter.

Marlet started his working career at American Chain & Cable Company as a machinist, ran his own gas station then moved into retail sales and purchasing. He held jobs as a buyer at various stores throughout the tri-state area before returning and retiring from Mailman's Department Stores.

Marlet Gotwalt was 86 years old when he passed away on Thursday, August 7th 2014. ³⁹

Marlet and Delores had a son and daughter.

1. Marlet L. Gotwalt Jr. who was born December 10th 1948 in York. He was 6 years old when he died from a skull fracture, resulting from an auto accident, April 2nd 1955. Marlet was laid to rest April 5th at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York. His father, Marlet Sr. was the informant on the death certificate. ⁴⁰
2. Laurie Gotwalt who married Mr. Mason and in 2014 lived in Newark, DE

Josephine Einzig (1857-1942)

Josephine Einzig was born September 21st 1857 to David Einzig and Christiana Ross in Freystown, Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. ⁴¹ She went by the name Sophia, and she married Wilhelm (William) Storll ^{xi}about 1874. In 1880 they lived near her family in Freystown.

William Storll was born November 12th 1847 in Saxony Germany. ⁴² He was 27 years old when he immigrated in 1872 to Pennsylvania. William was a basket maker in Freystown, and by 1900 the family was still living near other family members on Pattison Street in York Pennsylvania.

In 1910 Josephine's mother, Annie, lived with William and Josephine at 206 Pittson Street in York Pennsylvania.

William was 76 years old when he died at his home, 206 South Pattison Street in York, November 8th 1924. He was laid to rest November 12th at Mount Rose Cemetery. His son Charles D. Storll was the informant on William's death certificate. ⁴³ FAG#:15011243 ^{xii}

Josephine was 85 years old, living with her husband at 206 Pattison Street in York Pennsylvania, when she died December 17th 1942. She was laid to rest December 21st 1942 at the Mt. Rose cemetery. Her daughter, Edna M. Storll, was the informant on her death certificate. ⁴⁴ FAG#:150111119 ^{xiii}

In 1900 Josephine indicated she had four children, and all four were still living. In 1910 she indicated she had five children, and five were still living.

- i. William Adam Storll was born in August 1874 to William stroll and Josephine Einzig in Freystwon Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. ⁴⁵

William married Mayetta Messersmith on January 11th 1900 in York Pennsylvania. Mayetta was born November 30th 1876 to Alexander Messersmith and Martha Jane "Jennie" Gregg in York Pennsylvania.

In 1910 the family lived in Meadville, Crawford County Pennsylvania. At that time William was working as a molder for an Iron Factory, and later he became a maintenance foreman. The family lived at 992 ½ Park Avenue in Meadville.

Mayetta died April 7th 1945 in Meadville Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest at the Greendale Cemetery in Meadville. ^{xiv} FAG#:127089017

William was 88 years old when he died December 31st 1962 at his home. He was laid to rest January 4th 1963 at the Greendale Cemetery in Meadville. His daughter, Mrs. Dorothy Smith of Morton Mississippi, was the informant on his death certificate. ⁴⁶ FAG#:127089026

William and Mayetta Storll's children included:

- a. Bernard Richard Storll was born July 16th 1900 to William Storll and Mayetta Messersmith in York Pennsylvania. He married Anna Steele.

Bernard work as a fire equipment attendant, and lived at his father's family home lived at 992 ½ Park Avenue in Meadville, Crawford County Pennsylvania. Bernard was 58 years old when he died December 9th 1958 at Spencer Hospital in Meadville. He was laid to rest December 12th at the St. Brigids Cemetery, Plot: Section 5; Lot 23, Medaville. His wife Anna was the informant on his death certificate. ⁴⁷ FAG#:63700523

- b. Russell W. "Buss" Storll was born July 18th 1904 in Franklin Venango County Pennsylvania. He married Pauline Cole. Russell died May 30th 1975 in Meadville Crawford County Pennsylvania. Russell died May 30th 1975, and was laid to rest at the Evergreen Cemetery in Harmonsburg, Crawford County Pennsylvania. FAG#:38050665; Son of William Storll and Mayetta Messersmith; husband of Pauline Cole. ⁴⁸
- c. Dorothy Mae Storll was born May 25th 1913 in Meadville Crawford County Pennsylvania. ⁴⁹ In 1940 she lived with her family, and worked as a tabulator. When her father died in 1962, she was married to Cletus Smith, and she lived in Morton, Scott County Mississippi.

Cletus C. Smith was born on May 28th 1913 to Charles and Cora Smith in Meadville Pennsylvania. In 1950 Cletus and Dorothy lived in Hamden, New Haven Connecticut. ⁵⁰

Dorothy was 54 years old when she died September 24, 1967. She was laid to rest in Section 5 Lot 095, Grave #1 of the Saint Brigid Cemetery, Meadville Crawford County Pennsylvania. FAG#:156025298

Cletus was 57 years old when he died on April 4th 1971 in Greenville Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest in Section 5 Lot 095, Grave #2 of the Saint Brigid Cemetery. FAG#:63700470

- ii. Charles David Storll was born May 31st 1881 to William Storll and Josephine Einsig in Freystown, Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. Charles applied for a marriage License on June 24th 1899. He then married Julia A. Heckert on June 25th 1899 in York Pennsylvania. ⁵¹

The family lived at R.D. #5, Springettsbury Township York County Pennsylvania, ⁵² where Charles worked as a woodworker for the US Expansion Bolt Works in York.

He was 57 years old when he died at home on April 17th 1939. He was laid to rest April 20th at Mount Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Township York Pennsylvania. His wife Julia was the informant on his death certificate. ⁵³ FAG#:150111003 ^{xv}

- iii. Lilly J. (Josephine) Storll was born March 1887. She was with the family in 1900, but we cannot locate her after that.

- iv. Heinrich Arther (Arthur) Storll was born June 24th 1890 to William Storll and Josephine Einzig in Freystown Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. Heinrich was baptized September 17th 1890 at the St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church in York Pennsylvania.⁵⁴

Heinrich went by the English pronunciation and spelling of Heinrich; Harry Arthur Storll Harry married Catherine Loyd, and in 1920 they lived on 310 Lexington Avenue, and later moved to 952 East Princess Street in York Pennsylvania. When his sister, Edna, died in 1950 Harry and his family lived at 140 North Pine Street in York.

Harry was a wood worker at a table factory in York.

Harry and Catherine Storll's children included:

- a. Ann Storll was born in December 1918.
 - b. Harry Arthur Storll Jr. was born October 14th 1920 in York Pennsylvania. He died March 15th 1925, and was laid to rest March 17th at the Mount Rose Cemetery. His father Harry Storll was the informant on the death certificate.⁵⁵ FAG#:
 - c. Mary Storll was still born March 2nd 1928, and was laid to rest March 3rd at ****ightsville**.^{xvi} Her father Harry Storll was the informant on the death certificate.⁵⁶ FAG#:
- v. Edna Mae Storll was born October 19th 1900 to William Storll and Josephine Einzig in Freystown Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. Edna was baptized March 17th 1902 the St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church in York Pennsylvania.⁵⁷

Edna never married, lived at the family home at 206 Pattison Street in York, and worked as a machine operator at General Electric, and at a wire insulation plant in York Pennsylvania.

Edna was 49 years old when she died at the York Hospital on August 2nd 1950. She was laid to rest August 5th at Mount Rose Cemetery. Her brother Harry was the informant on her death certificate.⁵⁸ FAG#:150111323

Annie Theresa Einzig (1863-1932)

Annie Theresa Einzig was born November 23rd 1863 to David Einzig and Christiana Ross in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania.⁵⁹ She was 16 years old when she married 22 year old Jacob Greenawalt July 20th 1879 at the Christ Lutheran Church in York Pennsylvania.⁶⁰

Jacob Greenawalt was born January 18th 1857 to Lenard Greenawalt and Catherine Bentzel in York County Pennsylvania. Jacob's parents were both born in Germany. ⁶¹

In 1880 the family lived in Feystown; a few doors away from her parents David and Christiana Einzig. At the time Jacob was a basket maker. In 1900 the family lived at 19 Edison Street in York, where Jacob worked for a brush manufacturer.

Jacob was 52 years old when he died January 14th 1910 at his home, 655 East Edison Street in York. He was laid to rest January 17th at the Prospect Hill Cemetery. His wife, Mrs. Jacob Greenawalt, was the informant on his death certificate. ⁶² FAG#:156017703

Annie was 69 years old and living at 102 Finley Street in Springettsbury, when she died December 21st 1932. She was laid to rest on December 21st 1932 at Prospect Hill. Her daughter Irene Greenawalt was the informant. ⁶³ FAG#:156017797 ^{xvii}

In 1900 Annie indicated she had eight children, and that all eight were still living, but by 1910 she indicated she had nine children, and only eight were still living.

Adam was born June 5th 1871 to Peter Helfrich and Mary M. Witmer in Germany. ⁷⁴ Adam immigrated to Pennsylvania 1888, and was naturalized in 1892. He is the younger brother of Peter who married Mary's sister Catherine in 1891.
