

### Herman Einzig (1846-1927)

Herman Einzig was born March 4<sup>th</sup> 1846 to Anthony Einzig <sup>1</sup> and Eleanor Blum <sup>2</sup> in Baltimore Maryland. <sup>3</sup>

In 1850 Herman lived with his parents, and next door to his cousins, David <sup>4</sup> and John <sup>5</sup> Einzig. Like many of his family member's Herman was a basket maker. Herman married Julia Auble on January 2<sup>nd</sup> 1864 at the Christ Lutheran Church in York, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>6</sup> Julia Auble-Einzig died prior to 1870.

Herman then married Elizabeth Stempley about 1870. <sup>7</sup> Elizabeth was born January 6<sup>th</sup> 1850 to John Stempley in Baltimore Maryland. <sup>8</sup>

In 1870 Herman and Elizabeth lived next door to Elenora Auble, and David and Annie Einzig, in Dallastown York County. By 1880 the family was living in the small village of Healthville in Spring Garden Township York County. Sometime after 1880 the family moved from York County to Harrisburg in Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

The family lived at 1316 William Street in Harrisburg Pennsylvania, when at 81 years old, Herman died June 4<sup>th</sup> 1927. He was laid to rest June 7<sup>th</sup> 1927 at the Holy Cross Cemetery in Harrisburg. His wife, Elizabeth Einzig, was the informant on his death certificate, and she lived at 1806 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Harrisburg. <sup>9</sup>

Elizabeth was 81 years old when she died December 9<sup>th</sup> 1931 while living with her daughter, Katherine, at 1806 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest December 12<sup>th</sup> 1927 at the Holy Cross Cemetery in Harrisburg. Her daughter Mrs. Ira (Katherine) Meck, who also lived at 1806 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Harrisburg, was the informant. <sup>10</sup> FAG#:150923857 <sup>ii</sup>

Herman and Elizabeth indicated they had 5 children and 4 were still living in 1900.

- i. Rosa May Einzig (1871-1938). She 1<sup>st</sup> married Edward Nesor, and 2<sup>nd</sup> to George A. Morningstar.
- ii. Unknown Einzig Child born and died prior to 1900.
- iii. Katherine Mary Einzig (1874-1939). She 1<sup>st</sup> married Eugene F. Fitzgerald, and 2<sup>nd</sup> to Ira Meck.
- iv. Anthony John Einzig (1877-1960). He married Gertrude Zinn
- v. Leo Francis Einzig (1880-1953). He married Ida Hassler

## Rosa May Einsig (1871-1938)

Rosa May Einsig was born June 15<sup>th</sup> 1871 to Herman Einzig and Elizabeth Stempley<sup>iii</sup> in the Dallastown area<sup>iv</sup> of York County Pennsylvania.<sup>11</sup> Rose's name was also spelled as Rose and Rosie.

Rosa was 18 years old when she married 22 year old Frank C. Nesor<sup>12</sup> on May 1<sup>st</sup> 1890 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.<sup>13</sup> Frank was born September 25<sup>th</sup> 1868 to Edward Nesor in York Pennsylvania.<sup>14</sup>

Rosa and Frank lived in York, where their 1<sup>st</sup> child was born in 1891.<sup>15</sup> By 1900 the family owned a home at 553 East Philadelphia Street, and a child Blanch Wortz was identified as being adopted.

- Blanch Wortz was born March 1889. She cannot be located after 1900. It's uncertain if she was legally adopted. Blanch was not mention in the February 1901 charge against Rosa.

On February 7<sup>th</sup> 1901 someone reported Rosa to the local constable's office in York that Rosa was neglecting her children.<sup>16</sup> On February 8<sup>th</sup> 1901 George H. Loucks, a constable for the city of York, filed a complaint against Rosa. That on February 7<sup>th</sup> 1901, and on various other days and times within the last year, Rosa Nesor, the mother of minor children: Mary Nesor, Edward Nesor, Anna Rose Nesor, Lizzie Nesor, and Charley Nesor, did ill-treat, abuse, abandon, and neglect the minors.

- A warrant was issued for Rosa on February 8<sup>th</sup>, and the constable arrested her. Rosa didn't have any bail money, and she was placed in the county jail until her hearing scheduled for 7:00 o'clock P.M. February 13<sup>th</sup> 1901. After listening to the witnesses, and Rosa, the Justice of the Peace Franklin Leader, refused to rule on the case, and committed Rosa for the action of the next grand jury at the April 1901 session. Rosa's court trial was scheduled for 9:00 o'clock A.M. April 16<sup>th</sup> 1901 at the York County Court House. Two indictments were handed down.
- #1 Cruelty to Minors: On January 15<sup>th</sup> 1901 Rosa did unlawfully, willfully, and cruelly ill-treat, abuse, and inflict unnecessary cruel punishment and other wrongs on her children.
- #2 Neglect of Minors: On February 7<sup>th</sup> 1901 Rosa, then and there having care, custody, and control of her children, did unlawfully and willfully abandon, and neglect her children.

On April 16<sup>th</sup> 1901, Rosa was arraigned and pleaded guilty to indictment #2, and was sentenced to 10 days in the county jail, and to pay costs of prosecution.<sup>17</sup>

Soon after Rosa deserted Frank and the children, and they divorced on February 1<sup>st</sup> 1904 in York, York County Pennsylvania.<sup>18</sup> Edward was born 1868 to Edward and Josephine Nesor.<sup>19</sup>

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<sup>iii</sup> The name Mary Gundy was written on Rosa's death certificate, but Elizabeth was written on her marriage application with George Morningstar. Her husband George Morningstar was the informant on her death certificate, and we don't know who May Gundy is.

<sup>iv</sup> The family lived in Dallastown in 1870.

Rosa met George Albert Morningstar,<sup>20</sup> and they went to live at 425 North 8<sup>th</sup> Street in Philadelphia. She then married 34 year old George on June 1<sup>st</sup> 1905 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. George was previously married, and his divorced was settled January 21<sup>st</sup> 1905 in York, York County Pennsylvania.<sup>21</sup>

George was born April 24<sup>th</sup> 1871 to Henry C. Morningstar<sup>v</sup> and Leah Benedict in Pennsylvania.<sup>22</sup>

- After Rosa left, Frank<sup>23</sup> stayed in the home at 717 East Philadelphia Street in York. He was working as a safe maker when Lucy M. Sackenheim moved in with her children. Frank was 38 years old when he then married 28 year old Lucy M. Sackenheim on December 30<sup>th</sup> 1905 in York Pennsylvania. Lucy was born September 7<sup>th</sup> 1878 in Baltimore Maryland to Charles B. Hullmann and Christiana N. Neimeyer.<sup>24</sup> Lucy was previously married to Peter Sackenheim, who deserted her, and who she divorced on December 28<sup>th</sup> 1905.<sup>25</sup>
- By 1910 all of the children Frank had with Rosa were living with Frank and his new wife Lucy. There were 10 children living with them. At the time Frank was a laborer working at a safe works.
- Frank was 71 years old when he died July 26<sup>th</sup> 1940 in York. He was laid to rest July 29<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. His wife, Lucy, was the informant on his death certificate.<sup>26</sup> FAG#:101707008 Lucy died January 24<sup>th</sup> 1956. She was laid to rest January 27<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery. Lucy's daughter, Marguerite Barley, of 1710 South Royal Street in York, was the informant on Lucy's death certificate.<sup>27</sup> FAG#:101707009

By 1920 Rosa and George were renting a home at 130 Spruce Street in York. George worked as a shipping clerk for a carriage factory. There was a widowed aunt, Mary A. Hough (b. 1842 in PA), living with the family. By 1930 George and Rosa owned a home on Lancaster Avenue, and living with them was their adopted daughter, Lillian Morningstar, and a grandson, Paul C. Geiser.

George worked as a laborer for a body company, and in during the late 30's and 40s George worked for the Works Progress Administration removing tracks, and he worked as a wood finisher for the Weaver Piano Company in York.

Rosa was 67 years old, living with her husband George at 900 Lancaster Avenue in Spring Garden Township York Pennsylvania, when she died October 5<sup>th</sup> 1938. She was laid to rest October 8<sup>th</sup> at the Mt. Rose cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Her husband was the informant on her death certificate.<sup>28</sup> FAG#:122365846<sup>vi</sup>

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<sup>v</sup> Annie Einsig, daughter of David R. Einsig (1850-1911), who is another son of Anton Einzig (1804-1859), married 23 year old Norman E. Yeaple on September 16<sup>th</sup> 1913 in Carlisle Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Norman was born about 1890 to John E. Yeaple and Minnie E. Morningstar. There may be a relationship here.

After Rosa died, George went to live at 37 East Philadelphia Street in York. Living with him was a housekeeper, Lillian E. Seagar and her daughter Mable. George was 75 years old when he died in his room on November 11<sup>th</sup> 1946. He was laid to rest on November 13<sup>th</sup> at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York. Lillie E. Seager, of 37 East Philadelphia Street, was the informant on his death certificate.<sup>29</sup> FAG#:122365784

In the 1900 Rosa indicated she had five children born to Frank Nesor, and five were still living. In the 1901 case filed by Frank against Rosa for cruelty to minors, five children were identified.<sup>30</sup>

- i. Mary Anna Nesor was born March 24<sup>th</sup> 1891 to Frank C. Nesor and Rose M. Einsig in York Pennsylvania.<sup>31</sup>

Mary lived with her father in 1910. Mary was 21 years old when she married 21 year old Walter Eugene Titus on November 10<sup>th</sup> 1912 in Lynn Massachusetts. Walter was born March 27<sup>th</sup> 1892<sup>32</sup> to Samuel Titus and Mary Rader in Williamsport Pennsylvania.<sup>33</sup>

- Sometime prior to 1910, Walter moved from his parent's home in Lycoming County Pennsylvania, and went to live with his sister Sara Rentz in York Pennsylvania. The family lived at 1570 West King Street, and Walter was a wood finisher for a furniture company. This is the same profession as Anna's step father, George Morningstar.

Not long after they married the couple moved to Ohio, and by the time Walter registered for WWI service on June 5<sup>th</sup> 1917, the family lived on Oak Street in Orville Ohio. Walter was a brakeman on the Pennsylvania Railroad Company in Orville Ohio. In 1920 the couple had moved to Perry Township in Stark County Ohio, and lived at 829 Griffith Street. Walter was working as a laborer in a still mill.

In 1930 Walter was back working as a brakeman for the steam railway. The family rented a home on Almond Place in the city of Massillon, Township Stark County Ohio.

By the time Walter registered for WWII, Walter and his wife lived at 412 2<sup>nd</sup> Street in North East Massillon Ohio. At the time he listed his sister, Mrs. William Renz, at 1452 West King Street in York Pennsylvania, as his closest next of kin. At the time he was working for the Wheeling Lake Erie Railroad.<sup>34</sup>

When Mary's brother, Edward Nesor, died in 1970, Mary was still living in Massillon,<sup>35</sup> Township Stark County Ohio.

Walter retired in 1956 as a brakeman, and was 79 years old when he died December 8<sup>th</sup> 1971 at his home in Massillon located in Stark County Ohio. He was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania.<sup>36</sup> FAG#:108580995

Mary was 90 years old when she died August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1981 at the Massillon long term health care center, in Massillon, Stark County Ohio. Services were held at the St. Mary's Catholic Church in Massillon, and Mary was laid to rest August 6<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. <sup>37</sup> FAG#:108580994

- ii. Edward Franklin Nesor was born October 20<sup>th</sup> 1892 to Frank C. Nesor and Rose M. Einsig in York Pennsylvania. <sup>38</sup> He was living with his father in 1910. When Edward registered for the WWI draft on June 5<sup>th</sup> 1917, he lived at 305 Washington Street in Newark New Jersey. At the time he was not married, working as a salesman for the Carter Medicine Company at 45 Murray Street in New York, New York.

In 1930 Edward and his wife Ann L. Mount <sup>39</sup> were living in an apartment at 296 Cumberland Street in Brooklyn, Kings County New York. Ann must have been previously married to Mr. Mount. Edward worked for an advertiser in the sign department.

Ann was born December 12<sup>th</sup> 1895 <sup>40</sup> to Mr. Hurley <sup>41</sup> and Anna Lorenzen in Brooklyn, Kings County New York. <sup>42</sup>

Edward signed up for the WWII draft, and lived at 50 Welton Street in New Brunswick in Middlesex County New Jersey. At the time he worked at Wallace Laboratories in New Brunswick. <sup>43</sup>

After his step-father, George Morningstar, died in 1947, Edward and Ann took over George's home at 37 East Philadelphia Street in York. Ed worked 32 years of employment with Carter's products. He was a member of York Moose Lodge 148, Eaglets Aerie 183 and Orioles Nest 117. <sup>44</sup>

Edward was 77 years old when he died August 18<sup>th</sup> 1970, at the Pleasant Acres Hospital in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest on Friday August 21<sup>st</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. <sup>45</sup>

Ann died February 1988, <sup>46</sup> and was laid to rest with her husband at the Prospect Hill Cemetery.

Edward and Ann Nesor's children included: <sup>47</sup>

- a. George G. Nesor. When his father died in 1870, Georeg lived in Chesapeake Virginia.
- b. Mrs. Edward Gilloitti. She and her husband lived in West New York in New Jersey.

- iii. Charles H. Nesor was born April 28<sup>th</sup> 1894 to Frank C. Nesor and Rose M. Einsig in Spring Garden Township York Pennsylvania. <sup>48</sup> He was living with his father in 1910. On June 5<sup>th</sup> 1917 Charles signed up for the WW I draft in Montgomery County Pennsylvania. He was single, living on Ridge Road in the area of Conshohocken in Montgomery County, working as a laborer for a local contractor. <sup>49</sup>

- iv. Anna Rose Nesor<sup>50</sup> was born in 1896 to Frank C. Nesor and Rose M. Einsig in York Pennsylvania. She was living with her father in 1910.

Anna was 19 years old when her father gave his consent for her to marry 21 year old Spencer Leroy Newcomer.<sup>51</sup> They married on February 13<sup>th</sup> 1915 at the St Paul's Lutheran Church in York Pennsylvania.<sup>52</sup>

Spencer was born July 8<sup>th</sup> 1893<sup>53</sup> to Edward R. Spencer and Alice A. Armspaker in New Freedom in Shrewsbury Township York County Pennsylvania. Spencer's father was born in North Codorus Township and his mother in Codorus Township, both in York County Pennsylvania.<sup>54</sup>

The young couple lived at 1006 South Pine Street in York. Spencer worked as a truck driver for the York Paint and Color Company of York.<sup>55</sup>

In 1920 the young couple lived at 590 West King Street in York. Spencer was a Chauffeur for a local public bus company. Spence continued to work for the public bus company, and they bought a home at 617 East York Street in York. By 1940 Spencer was working as a truck driver for Adams Transit Company. Living with them at the time was an orphan girl, Betty Jane Gross. Betty was born 1924 in Pennsylvania.

When Anna's brother, Edward Nesor, died in 1970, Anna and Spencer were still living at 617 York Street in York.<sup>56</sup>

Anna died in 1971, and was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. FAG#:101707073  
Spencer died in 1984, and was laid to rest with his wife. FAG#:101707090

Spencer and Anna Newcomer's children included:

- a. Spencer Leroy Newcomer Jr. was born June 23<sup>rd</sup> 1916 in York Pennsylvania. He died June 4<sup>th</sup> 1992 in York.<sup>57</sup> Spencer was a carpenter, and married Jean Sellers, who remarried to a Mr. Mason prior to 1992).<sup>58</sup> Spencer Jr. enlisted as a private into the Army Air Corp in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania on October 8<sup>th</sup> 1942.<sup>59</sup>

Spencer achieved the rank of Staff Sergeant, and was discharged October 13<sup>th</sup> 1945. He lived in Westminster Maryland, and in 1979 moved to the city of Bushnell in Sumter County, Florida.

He was a retired road manager for the Baltimore News America, a veteran of World War II, serving in the U.S. Army Air Corps, a member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Chester McKay Post in New Port Richey, Door of Virtue Masonic Lodge 46 Ancient Free and Accepted Masons in Westminster, the Scottish Rite, Boumi Temple Shrine, and Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Aripeka Lodge 2520 in Hudson. He was Lutheran.<sup>60</sup>

Spencer was 75 years old when he died Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> 1992 at the New Port Richey Hospital. <sup>61</sup> He was laid to rest at the Florida National Cemetery, Plot: 104-0-1917, located near the city of Bushnell in Sumter County, Florida. FAG#:128733133

Spencer and Jean Newcomer's children included: <sup>62</sup>

1. Spencer Leroy Newcomer III was born November 29<sup>th</sup> 1940 to Spencer Leroy Newcomer Jr. and Jean Sellers.

Spencer was a graduate of the class of 1958 of William Penn Senior High School. He was a Corporal in the Maines, and participated in the Vietnam War. Spencer married Jean Ann Ferrara, and they lived at 1721 Paulson Drive in York.

He was employed by GTE - Valenite Corporation. He belonged to both Victory and Viking Athletic associations. When his father died in 1992, Spencer the III lived in York Pennsylvania.

He was 51 years old when he died, from a lengthy illness, on Saturday at home, October 31<sup>st</sup> 1992. He was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. <sup>63</sup> FAG#:13347000

2. Stephanie Newcomer to Spencer Leroy Newcomer Jr. and Jean Sellers. When her father died in 1992, she was married to Mr. Carl, and they lived in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania.
3. Melanie Newcomer to Spencer Leroy Newcomer Jr. and Jean Sellers. When her father died in 1992, she was married to Mr. Holtzapple, and they lived in Dover York County Pennsylvania.
4. Philip Grim of Dover. He is most likely a half-brother. <sup>64</sup>
5. Diane Shearer of York Pennsylvania. She is most likely a half-sister. <sup>65</sup>
6. Michelle Shellenberger of York. She is most likely a half-sister. <sup>66</sup>

- b. Edward Ray Newcomer was born September 23<sup>rd</sup> 1924. Since his birth he had problems breathing, due to congestion in his lungs. Edward was one month old when he died on October 4<sup>th</sup> 1924 at home. He was laid to rest October 6<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill cemetery in York. His father was the informant on Edward's death certificate. <sup>67</sup> FAG#:101707077

- v. Elizabeth J. Nesor was born December 25<sup>th</sup> 1897 to Frank C. Nesor and Rose M. Einsig in York Pennsylvania. <sup>68</sup> She sometimes went by the name Lizzie, and in 1910, she lived with her father and his new wife Lucy.

Elizabeth married Frank Roman Geiser about 1915. Frank was born January 16<sup>th</sup> 1892 <sup>69</sup> in York Pennsylvania. On June 5<sup>th</sup> 1917, when Frank registered for the WW I draft, the young couple lived at 869 East Popular Street in York. Frank was working as a pressman for the Smtizer and Royer Company. <sup>70</sup>

Elizabeth was 20 years old when she died at home on March 28<sup>th</sup> 1918 from epidemic cerebrospinal meningitis. She was laid to rest March 29<sup>th</sup> at St. Marys Cemetery. <sup>vii</sup> Her husband, Frank, was the informant on her death certificate. <sup>71</sup> FAG#:158247795

After Elizabeth died, 24 year old Frank continued to live at 869 East Popular Street in York with his son Paul, and housekeeper Cora Winters. He was working as a molder for an iron foundry.

- Frank Geiser then married Cora E. Winters January 15<sup>th</sup> 1920 in York Pennsylvania. <sup>72</sup>
- In 1930 the family lived near York Street and Baltimore Road to Keeneys Mill. In 1930 Frank tried his hand as a farmer, and he and Cora lived with Cora's brother Charles S. Winter, and their children.
- Frank and Cora had three children.
  - Mary E. Geiser was born in 1923
  - Josephine Leah Geiser was born to Frank R. Geiser and Cora E. Winters on August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1925 in Winterstown, York County Pennsylvania. She married Mr. Brown prior to 1950, and by 1951 she was married to Mr. Appleby. Josephine died May 20<sup>th</sup> 1992. <sup>73</sup>
  - Robert Roman Geiser was born December 24<sup>th</sup> 1928 to Frank R. Geiser and Cora E. Winters on August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1925 in Glen Rock, York County Pennsylvania. Robert died January 8<sup>th</sup> 1995. <sup>74</sup>
- In April 27<sup>th</sup> 1942, Frank sine duo for the W II draft, and at the time he was living in R.D#2 in the Glenn Rock area of York County Pennsylvania.
- Frank died August 1968. <sup>75</sup>

Elizabeth and Frank Geiser's children included:

- a. Paul Frank Geiser was born December 27<sup>th</sup> 1917 to Frank Geiser and Elizabeth Neser in York Pennsylvania. <sup>76</sup>

In 1920 he lived with his father, and his new wife Cora. By 1930 he was living with his grandmother, Rosa and George Morningstar on Lancaster Avenue in York. Paul died March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2001, <sup>77</sup> and was laid to rest at Susquehanna Memorial Gardens in York, York County Pennsylvania. FAG#: 59811246

Rosa and George Morningstar had two children.

- i. Lillian Morningstar was born in 1916, and adopted by George Albert Morningstar and Rosa May Einsig. She was living with the family in 1930. It's uncertain if the adoption was through the local civil court.
- ii. Glenn George Morningstar was born April 5<sup>th</sup> 1931 to George Albert Morningstar and Rosa May Einsig in Manhattan, New York County, New York.

Glenn enlisted into the Army, and participated in the Korean War. He was honorably discharged, and a recipient of the Purple Heart, Bronze Star, and Korean Campaign Medal, and had his name placed on the Monument of Valor.

Glenn married Dorothy Marie Leicht in York, where he held numerous full time jobs, and eventually became a correctional officer for York County, from where he retired. Glenn was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter-day Saints. He enjoyed farming, genealogy, and was an all-around outdoorsman. He was active in the Coast Guard Auxiliary and enjoyed participating in Native American activities.

Glenn was 82 years old when he died Wednesday December 25<sup>th</sup> 2013 at the York Hospital in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest December 30<sup>th</sup>, with a flag folding ceremony performed by the York County Veterans Honor Guard and Veterans and Native Americans of his family, at the Susquehanna Memorial Gardens in York County Pennsylvania. <sup>78</sup> FAG#:122363375

Glenn and Dorothy had 12 children, who were all alive when Glenn died in 2013.

### Katherine Mary Einzig (1874-1939)

Katherine Mary <sup>viii</sup> Einzig was born September 16<sup>th</sup> 1874 to Herman Einzig and Elizabeth Stempley in the Dallastown area of York County Pennsylvania. <sup>79</sup>

Katherine 1<sup>st</sup> married Eugene F. Fitzgerald on February 14<sup>th</sup> 1899 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. <sup>80</sup> Eugene was born October 1871 to Patrick Fitzgerald and Annie Reedy in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Both of Eugene's parents were born in Ireland. <sup>81</sup>

By 1944 Anthony was working as a repairman and the family was living at 2619 Lexington Street in Harrisburg. <sup>99</sup> By 1950 the family lived at 101 South Summit Street in Harrisburg.

Gertrude was 75 years old when she died at home on January 31<sup>st</sup> 1953. She was laid to rest February 4<sup>th</sup> at the Rolling Green Cemetery in Camp Hill Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Elizabeth and Fred were members of the Messiah Lutheran Church, and Elizabeth was a member of the church's Silver Threads. <sup>107</sup>

When the Police arrived they found Michael in the backyard with a Poulon 14-inch chainsaw. Officers learned Einzig had come home and discovered a male neighbor sleeping on the living room floor, and Einzig's live-in girlfriend asleep in the bedroom.

Police say Einzig physically assaulted his girlfriend with the running chainsaw, and damaged the home by cutting into the drywall. According to police, Einzig then chased the neighbor out of the house and threatened to cut him into pieces. At some point, the chainsaw stalled, and Einzig was unable to restart it. Police say the neighbor suffered bruises in the assault, and Einzig cut his own hands on the chainsaw.

- vi. William John Einzig was born May 28<sup>th</sup> 1905 <sup>150</sup> to Anthony J. Einsig and Gertrude Zinn in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He was with the family in 1910, 1920, and 1930, but not 1940.

William enlisted into the Army on February 3<sup>rd</sup> 1942 at the Army Supply Depot, Military Entrance Personnel Recruiting in New Cumberland, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. He was discharged September 3<sup>rd</sup> 1943 at Fort Benning Georgia. <sup>151</sup>

In 1944 William lived with his parents at 2619 Lexington Street in Harrisburg. He was a supervisor in the employment office at the Middletown Air Depot in Middletown, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. <sup>152</sup>

By June 12<sup>th</sup> 1950 William was living in Harrisburg, where he applied for his WW II compensation. William married Ha Ku, <sup>153</sup> and was a retired federal government employee.

When William's sister Elizabeth died in 1988, William lived in Port Charlotte, Florida, <sup>154</sup> and later in 1990 he lived in Thousand Oaks, Ventura County California.

William was 92 years old when he died Wednesday October 15<sup>th</sup> 1997 in Los Robles Hospital, Thousand Oaks California. He was laid to rest at the Rolling Green Cemetery in Lower Allen Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>155</sup> FAG#:152302467

William and Ha Ku had a child

- a. Incha Ku Einzig was born July 9<sup>th</sup> 1941. In 1998 Incha lived at 363 Hodencamp Road in Thousand Oaks, California. In 1992 she lived at Fort Charlotte and Punta Gorda in Florida, and by 1996 she lived at 557 New York Ave NE. <sup>156</sup>

- vii. Dorothy Marie Einzig was born July 28<sup>th</sup> 1908 to Anthony J. Einsig and Gertrude Zinn in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. She was with the family in 1910 and 1920, but not 1930 or 1940.

Sometime prior to 1929, Dorothy married John Myers, and by 1937 she had married John M. Kauffman. When Dorothy's brother, Robert, died in February 1937, Dorothy and John Kauffman lived in Rutherford Heights, Harrisburg. <sup>157</sup> John was born August 8<sup>th</sup> 1905. <sup>158</sup>

By 1940 John and Dorothy were still renting a home at 321 Tioga Street in Rutherford Heights, Harrisburg. John was a pipefitter for the steam railroad company in Harrisburg.

John Kauffman died in September 1972, and was laid to rest at the Blue Ridge Memorial Gardens, Harrisburg Pennsylvania. <sup>159</sup> FAG#:78634080

Leo was working on Engines for the Pennsylvania Railroad, and by 1920 the family lived at 421 Woodbine Street in Harrisburg. Leo was a machinist for the Pennsylvania Railroad. In 1930 the family, along with Ida's mother Alice E. Hassler, was living at 421 Woodbine, and Leo was still working for the Pennsylvania Railroad.

By 1935 Leo, Ida, and Alice Hassler moved to West Medford, Middle Essex, Mississippi, and by 1940 the family, along with Alice Hassler, was back living at 201 Madison Avenue in Lower Paxton, Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

When Leo signed up for the W II draft on April 25<sup>th</sup> 1942, the family was living at 1804 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street, and Leo indicated that he had not been working for seven years due to arthritis. <sup>186</sup>

In 1944 Leo was working as a shop worker for the Pennsylvania Railroad, and by 1950 Leo and Ida lived at 1804 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. <sup>187</sup>

Leo was 72 years old when died at the Policlinic Hospital in Harrisburg, and was laid to rest September 9<sup>th</sup> 1953 at the Shoops Cemetery in Harrisburg. L. Hassler Einzig from 8 Field Road Arlington Massachusetts was the informant. <sup>188</sup> FAG#:50631173
