

## Jacob Einsig (1870-1930)

Jacob Einsig was born March 16<sup>th</sup> 1870 to John (George) Einsig <sup>1</sup> and Mary (Catherine) Reichardt (Rhinehart) <sup>2</sup> in Reading Berks County Pennsylvania. <sup>3</sup>

Jacob was a basket maker when he married Rose Myers <sup>4</sup> in 1890 in Schuylkill County. Rose was born March 16<sup>th</sup> 1870 to Peter and Hanna (Annie) Myers in York, York County Pennsylvania. Both of Rose's parent's were born in Germany. Rose also went by the name Rosie. <sup>5</sup>

- John Einsig (1831-1915) married Teresa Berger, and they had a daughter Annie who married Peter Myers. <sup>6</sup>

In 1905 Jacob and his family lived in Marietta and in 1906 a few miles East in Columbia, Lancaster County Pennsylvania. Jacob's brother, George William Einsig (1861-1937), <sup>7</sup> also lived in this area.

By 1910 Jacob was still making baskets, and the family had moved from Lancaster County to 1729 Colton Street in Reading Berks County Pennsylvania.

In 1920 the family had moved again to 1331 Seneca Street in Pottsville Schuylkill County Pennsylvania. Next door was Patrick and Lillie Love.

Jacob lived with his son Peter at 307 North 7<sup>th</sup> Street in Pottsville Schuylkill County Pennsylvania. It was here Jacob, at 60 years old, died October 16<sup>th</sup> 1930. He was laid to rest October 20<sup>th</sup> at the Mount Laural Cemetery <sup>i</sup> in Norwegian Township Schuylkill County Pennsylvania. Jacob's son Peter was the informant on Jacob's death certificate. <sup>8</sup> FAG#: 156444947 <sup>ii</sup>

Rosie was 62 years old when she died November 18<sup>th</sup> 1933 at the Pottsville Hospital in Pottsville Schuylkill County. She was laid to rest with her husband November 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Mount Laural Cemetery in Pottsville. Her daughter Viola of Cressona Schuylkill County Pennsylvania was the informant on Rossie's death certificate. <sup>9</sup> FAG#: 156445008 <sup>iii</sup>

In 1910 Rose indicated she had eight children and eight were still living

- i. Anna Einsig was born 1891. She married Mr. Stanley about 1906, and they had a child Charles Stanley, who was born in 1908. In 1910 Anna and her child lived with Anna's parents at 1729 Colton Street Reading Berks County Pennsylvania.
- ii. Lillie Einsig was born 1892. May have married Patrick Love, and in 1920 lived next door to her Einsig family at 1329 Seneca Street in Pottsville Schuylkill County Pennsylvania.
- iii. Peter Adam Einsig was born 1894. With the family in 1920
- iv. Viola Einsig was born 1894

- v. Evelyn Einsig was born November 28<sup>th</sup> 1895 to Jacob Einsig and Rose Myers in Lancaster County Pennsylvania. She married Dennis Love. The family lived at R.D. #3 Lebanon, Lebanon County Pennsylvania. It was here at 51 years old Evelyn died January 22<sup>nd</sup> 1947. She was laid to rest the same day at the Odd Fellows Cemetery in Pottsville Schuylkill County Pennsylvania. Mrs. Edward Menning of R.D.# 3 Lebanon was the informant of Evelyn's death certificate. <sup>10</sup> FAG#: <sup>iv</sup>
- vi. Madeline Einsig was born December 23<sup>rd</sup> 1898 to Jacob Einsig and Rose Myers in Marietta Lancaster County Pennsylvania. <sup>11</sup>

Madeline was 15 years old and living with her parents in the city of Lancaster, Lancaster County Pennsylvania, when she married 14 year old Elmer Franklin Null on April 9<sup>th</sup> 1914 in Lancaster. <sup>12</sup>

Elmer was working in the Sutter Umbrella Factory in Lancaster. He was born about 1900 to Elmer Null and Katie Strands in Columbia Lancaster County. Elmer's father was born in Strasburg Township Lancaster County, and his mother in West Hempfield Township Lancaster County. <sup>13</sup>

Madeline came to live at 713 Harrison Street in Pottsville, where at 45 years old she died August 30<sup>th</sup> 1944. She was laid to rest September 1<sup>st</sup> in Pottsville. Pearl Heiney of Pottsville was the informant on Madeline's death certificate. <sup>14</sup> FAG#: <sup>v</sup>

- vii. Hezekiah Edward Einsig was born 1902. With the family in 1920
- viii. Elwood Einsig was born March 6<sup>th</sup> 1905 to Jacob Einsig and Rosie Myers in Marietta Lancaster County Pennsylvania. Elwood was one year old when he died March 6<sup>th</sup> 1906, at his family's home on Charles Avenue in Columbia Lancaster County. He was laid to rest March 8<sup>th</sup> in York, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>15</sup> FAG#: <sup>vi</sup>
- ix. Alberta Einsig was born 1907. With the family in 1920
- x. Hilda Einsig was born in 1910. With the family in 1920
- xi. Pearl Einsig was born in 1914. With the family in 1920
