

## Jacob Eugene Einzig (1884-1969)

Jacob (Jake) Eugene Einsig Sr. <sup>1</sup> was born September 15<sup>th</sup> 1884 <sup>2</sup> to John George Einsig Jr. <sup>3</sup> and Lizzie Ritter <sup>4</sup> in the Freystown <sup>1</sup> area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania.

In 1900 Jake, his mother and siblings lived in the home of Samuel and Annie Matson at 719 Girard Street York Pennsylvania.

Jacob was 20 years old, living with his family at 323 Girard Avenue in York Pennsylvania, when his father signed his consent for Jacob to marry on August 8<sup>th</sup> 1905. Jacob then married 17 year old <sup>ii</sup> Bernetta (Nettie) May <sup>iii</sup> Wolford in York Pennsylvania. <sup>5</sup> Nettie's father, Jonas Wolford, also gave his consent for his daughter Nettie to marry.

Nettie was born June 2<sup>nd</sup> 1891 and lived with her parents, Jonas and Ida Wolford, on Willow Row in York with her parents, Jonas and Ida Wolford.

- The family oral history indicated that Nettie had Native American blood...maybe part gypsy.

After they married, Jake and Nettie went to live on Black Bridge Road in Manchester Township in York County Pennsylvania. <sup>iv</sup> Living with the young family was Nettie's sister, Maggie Wolford-Stair who was born in 1884. Maggie indicated she was married about 1902 and had no children,

In 1920 the family lived at 615 King Street in York, where John worked as a laborer in a wire cloth business. By 1930 the family was living at 132 Orange Alley in York Pennsylvania, <sup>v</sup> where Jacob worked as a laborer in a Junk Yard; most likely with his Uncles and Cousins. In 1940 the family migrated to another part of York County, about 30 miles North-West, near the small town of Wellsville in York County Pennsylvania, where Jacob was working for a road construction business as a laborer.

Nettie died May 6<sup>th</sup> 1955, and was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery <sup>vi</sup> in York Pennsylvania

Jacob Einsig lived at 17365 Wellsville, York, Pennsylvania when he died in March 1969. <sup>6</sup> He was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery with his wife. FAG#:11749413 <sup>vii</sup>

## Harry Elswood Einsig (1907-1991)

Harry Elswood Einsig was born January 3<sup>rd</sup> 1907<sup>7</sup> to Jacob Eugene Einsig and Bernetta (Nettie) May Wolford in York Pennsylvania.

Harry married Bruehilda Blanche Smith, who was born March 31<sup>st</sup> 1916.<sup>8</sup> Bruehilda was previously married to Mr. Stare, and they had a son Ronald E. Stare, Sr. Ronald died prior to 2009, when his half brother, Harry A. Einsig died.<sup>9</sup>

In 1940 Harry and his family were living at 724 East King Street in York Pennsylvania, where Harry worked as a general laborer.

Bruehilda died July 1883,<sup>10</sup> and Harry died January 9<sup>th</sup> 1991.<sup>11</sup>

Harry and Bruehilda had five children.

- i. Robert J. Einsig was born 1935. When his brother Harry died in 2009, Robert was living in York.
- ii. Anna Mae Einsig was born 1936. She married Mr. Foller, and when her brother Harry died in 2009, Anna was living in York.
- iii. Bernetta J. Einsig was born 1938. She married Mr. Myers, and when her brother Harry died in 2009, Bernetta was living in York.
- iv. Norman E. Einsig was born 1939. When his brother Harry died in 2009, Robert was living in York.
- v. Harry "Pete" A. Einsig was born December 29<sup>th</sup> 1940 in York Pennsylvania. He married Caryl J. Rudy in June 11<sup>th</sup> 1961. Harry worked and retired as a maintenance mechanic from ACCO, and he was a member of the Liberty Club.<sup>12</sup>

Harry was 68 years old when he died Monday May 4<sup>th</sup> 2009 at the York Hospital in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest at the Susquehanna Memorial Gardens, 250 Chestnut Hill Rd, York, Pennsylvania. FAG#:36783322<sup>viii</sup>

Harry and Caryl have two daughters.

### Jacob Eugene Einsig Jr. (1923-1998)

Jacob (Jake) Eugene Einsig Jr. was born June 8<sup>th</sup> 1923 to Jacob Eugene Einsig and Bernetta (Nettie) May Wolford in York Pennsylvania.

Jacob Jr. died November 6<sup>th</sup> 1998

Jacob was single, standing 5' 6" at 133 pounds when he enlistment September 8<sup>th</sup> 1942 as a private in a field artillery unit during WW II in Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. <sup>13</sup>

Jacob died November 6<sup>th</sup> 1998 while living in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest in the Mt. Rose Cemetery in York. FAG#:11749432 <sup>ix</sup>

### Samuel F. Einsig Sr. (1925-2010)

Samuel F. Einsig Sr. was born January 4<sup>th</sup> 1925 to Jacob Eugene Einsig and Bernetta (Nettie) May Wolford in York Pennsylvania. <sup>14</sup>

Sam married Irene E. Hess, <sup>15</sup> who was born June 2<sup>nd</sup> 1923 to Bruce E. Hess and Clara Belle Stroll in York County Pennsylvania. <sup>16</sup>

Sam was a U.S. Army Air Corps veteran of World War II. He retired in 1981 following 34 years of service for Medusa Cement Co. where he worked as a crusher operator. He enjoyed hunting, CB radio, and camping. He was also an avid NASCAR fan. <sup>17</sup>

Irene died September 10<sup>th</sup> 1989, and was laid to rest at the Dover Union Cemetery Dover York County Pennsylvania. FAG#:133538733 <sup>x</sup>

After Irene died Sam married Bessie Crane in June 1993. They lived in Wellsville were they remained married until Sam died in 2010. <sup>18</sup>

Robert E. Einsig Sr. was born November 10<sup>th</sup> 1927 1907 (8/1/27) to Jacob Eugene Einsig and Bernetta (Nettie) May Wolford in Warrington Township York County Pennsylvania. <sup>24</sup>

Robert married Betty C. Criswell who was born in 1925. He then enlisted in the Army September 29<sup>th</sup> 1950 during the Korean War. Robert reached the rank of Sergeant before he was honorably discharged in September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1956.

Betty was previously married, and they had a daughter Marcy who married Mr. Nance. <sup>25</sup>

Robert was a U.S. Army veteran, and worked as a machine operator for Donlee Technologies Inc., where he was employed 40 years. <sup>26</sup>
