John Edward Einsig Sr. (1882-1951)

John Edward Einsig was born October 3rd 1882 to John George Einsig Jr.¹ and Lizzie Ritter² in the Freystownⁱ area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania.³

John married Marguerite (Maggie) Lauber about 1903. ⁴ Maggie was born August 31st 1884 to Herman L. Lauber and Mary Lark in Pennsylvania. ⁵

John stood 5' 6" tall and weighed 130 pounds. He had brown eyes and hair, with a "ruddy" complexion. John had a tattoo on his right forearm; Clasp Hands and Star.⁶

In 1920 an Albert Einsig was living with the family at 700 King Street in York Pennsylvania. The family continued to grow with more children, and lived at 750 East King Street in York Pennsylvania.

Shortly after becoming pregnant with her son, James, Maggie began to become ill in June 1927. Her Doctor began to visit in July 1927, and he must have eventually diagnosed her illness as acute Myocarditis. ⁱⁱ Over the remainder of the year her conditioned didn't subside, and instead became chronic. On March 27th 1928, at 48 years old, Maggie died of Chronic Mycocarditis at her home at 750 East King Street.

Maggie was laid to rest March 31st at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Albert Lauber was the informant on her death certificate. ⁷ FAG#:140435627 ⁱⁱⁱ

By 1930 John was a widow living at his home on East King Street. In April 27th 1942 John registered for the Military Draft. At the time his son Herman was listed as the person who would always know where John was. Herman lived at 754 East King Street in York.⁸

John was living at 650 East King Street in York Pennsylvania, when he began to become ill. He was 68 years old when he died Monday, July 9th 1951, at the York Hospital in York. Services were conducted Friday at 10 a.m. with the Rev. Paul J. Seltzer, pastor of Bethany Moravian church, officiating. John was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery. ⁹ John's daughter, Eva Kuhn of 866 South Popular Street in York Pennsylvania, was the informant on John's death certificate. ¹⁰ FAG#:140436444

John Einsig was born April 6th 1909¹⁷ to John Edward Einsig and Marguerite Lauber in York, York County Pennsylvania.

He enlisted into WW II on November 18th 1943, and was honorably discharged December 25th 1945. John married Pauline K. and they came to live in Boward County Florida. Pauline K. was born October 15th 1910. ¹⁸
