

### Joseph Leo Einsig (1870-1943)

Joseph Leo Einsig was born October 23<sup>rd</sup> 1870 to George Einsig and Barbara Gehring <sup>1</sup> in Freystown <sup>i</sup> Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. <sup>2</sup> Joseph lived with his parents at the home of his grandmother, Elenora Einsig, on Ridge Avenue in Freystown.

Then in 1877 Joseph's mother took her children to live with her parent's in the old neighborhood of Bull Frog Alley in Freystown. After Joseph's mother was murdered by his father, <sup>3</sup> Joseph and his siblings continued to live with their grandparents, Andrew and Mary Gehring.

Like many of his family members, Joseph was a basket maker and weaver.

Joseph was 23 years old when he married 19 year old Emma Jane Wire on April 15<sup>th</sup> 1895 in York Pennsylvania. Emma's father, Henry Wire of Spring Garden Township York County, gave his consent for Emma to marry Joseph. <sup>4</sup> Emma was born in May 9<sup>th</sup> 1876 to Henry Weir and Mary H. Seiple in York County Pennsylvania. Both Henry and Mary were born in York County. <sup>5</sup>

Joseph lived at 734 East King Street York. Since July 30<sup>th</sup> he was at the Harrisburg State Hospital in Susquehanna Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania, where at 72 years old he died August 17<sup>th</sup> 1943. He was laid to rest August 19<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. <sup>6</sup> FAG#:43969401 <sup>ii</sup>

Emma continued to live at 734 East King Street. She was 68 years old when she died April 1<sup>st</sup> 1945 at the York Hospital in York. She was laid to rest on April 5<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. Her son Albert, of 740 East King Street in York, was the informant on her death certificate. <sup>7</sup> FAG#:43969431

In 1910 Emma indicated she had five children, and five were still living.

Joseph and Emma Einsig's children include:

- i. Arthur Eugene Einsig was born July 4<sup>th</sup> 1895 to Joseph Leo Einsig and Emma Jane Wire <sup>8</sup> in the old Freystown area of York Pennsylvania. Arthur was with the family in 1900, but died on February 2<sup>nd</sup> 1902. (unknown source)
- ii. Barbara Mary Einsig (1898-1956). She married Michael Welt.
- iii. Andrew David Einsig (1900-1974). He married Catherine V. Arnold.

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<sup>i</sup> Freystown was a flourishing community with a rich history just east of York city, bounded approximately by Broad Street, King Street, Harrison Street and Philadelphia Street. Early settlement centered on what is now East Market Street around Ridge Avenue and Diehl's Mill Road (Sherman Street). Freystown became part of York city around 1900 (sources vary), but not without reluctance.

- iv. Harry Joseph Einsig was born November 9<sup>th</sup> 1903<sup>iii</sup> in York Pennsylvania. Harry worked as a candy maker for the American Carmel Company at 734 East King Street in York. He was almost 15 years old when he died October 17<sup>th</sup> 1918 at the York Hospital from Septicemia, caused from a injury to his right hand while he was working around a piece of machine at the American Carmel Company. Harry was laid to rest October 21<sup>st</sup> at the Mount Rose Cemetery. His father, Joseph, was the informant on Harry's death certificate. <sup>9</sup> FAG#:158163412
- v. Nettie Cecilio Einsig (1905-1954). She married Robert Franklin Arnold.
- vi. Pauline Einsig (1908-1978). She married Lester Martin Tyson.
- vii. Albert Harry Einsig (1911-1975). He married Florence L. Briggs

#### Barbara Mary Einsig (1896-1956)

Barbara Mary Einsig was born November 29<sup>th</sup> 1896<sup>iv</sup> to Joseph Leo Einsig and Emma Jane Wire in the old Freystown area of York Pennsylvania. Barbara also went by the name Mary, and she was with the family in 1900 and 1910, but not in 1920.

Barbra married Michael Welt. <sup>10</sup> Michael was born in 1895 in Germany. <sup>v</sup> The family lived next door to Barbara's parents on King Street in York, where Michael was a junk dealer. By 1930 the family had moved to 118 Pattison Street in York, and Michael was still in the junk business. Michael's brother Solomon (b. 1887 in Germany) also lived with the family in 1930.

Barbara and Michael divorced, and Barbara lived with her son Robert at 1044 Edison Street in York.

Barbara was 59 years old she died August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1956 at home. Barbara was laid to rest at Mt Rose Cemetery in Spring Garden Township in York Pennsylvania. Her son Robert S. Welt was the informant on her death certificate. <sup>11</sup> FAG#:158122643 <sup>vi</sup>

Barbra and Michael Welt's children included:

- i. Viola Welt was born in 1916
- ii. Charles Welt was born in 1920
- iii. Albert Welt was born in 1922

Harry was 14 years, 11 months, and 8 days old when he died on October 17<sup>th</sup> 1918, making his birth date November 9<sup>th</sup> 1903.

<sup>iv</sup> Barbara's birth year is an error.

<sup>v</sup> The 1930 census record indicated that Michael was born in Italy, which we believe is an error.

Andrew David Einsig (1900-1974)

Andrew David Einsig was born October 1<sup>st</sup> 1900<sup>12</sup> to Joseph Leo Einsig and Emma Jane Wire in the old Freystown area of York Pennsylvania.

- Arthur Einsig Name, Birth Date, Place of Birth, and Parent's Names: The information came from the Birth Records (1893-1906), Date of Birth: 05/17/1901, Gender: Male, Book: 03, Page: 054, York County Archives, 150 Pleasant Acres Road York Pennsylvania 17402.

Andrew was 21 years old when he married 21 year old Catherine Viola Arnold on May 20<sup>th</sup> 1922 in York Pennsylvania. Catherine was born in 1901 to Adam Arnold and Hattie Morningstar.<sup>13</sup>

In 1930 Andrew lived at 217 East King Street in York, where he worked for a pretzel bakery. When his son, Wilbur, married in 1941 the family lived at 711 East King Street. By the time Andrew's father died in 1943, Andrew and his family lived on Franklin Street in York.

Andrew worked thirty years for the Borg-Warner Engineering Company, and was part of its 25 year club. .

Andrew was 73 years old, 14 days shy of his 74<sup>th</sup> birthday, when he died Wednesday May 1<sup>st</sup> 1974 at the York Hospital. He was laid to rest at the Greenmount Cemetery in York. FAG#:88388200

After Andrew died, Catherine continued to live in York. She died in 1981 and was laid to rest with her husband at the Greenmount Cemetery. FAG#:88388212

Andrew and Catherine children included:

- i. Wilbur Andrew Einsig was born in 1923. Wilbur was 18 years old when he applied for a marriage license on December 20<sup>th</sup> 1941. Then on December 27<sup>th</sup> 1941 Wilbur married 19 year old Mae Idelta Kapp. Mae was born in 1922 to Henry S. Kapp and Florence E. Beck in Dover Township York County Pennsylvania. Henry was born in Warrington Township York County, and Florence was born in Springfield Township York County.<sup>14</sup>

When Wilbur married he lived with his parents at 711 East King Street in York, and worked for the Tioga Silk Mill. Mae's father had died, and she lived with her mother at R.D. #1 Dover, and worked at the National Biscuit Company.<sup>15</sup>

When his father, Andrew, died in 1974 Wilbur lived at 704 East Philadelphia Street in York.

Mae died in 1979, FAG#:88388235, and Wilbur died in 1991, and they were both laid to rest at the Greenmount Cemetery in York. FAG#:88388223

Wilbur and Mae Einsig's children included:

- a. Darlene Einsig who married Mr. Lahr. When her brother Barry died in 2010 Darlene lived in Dover York County Pennsylvania. <sup>16</sup>
- b. Barry Wilbur Einsig was born in 1943. He married Stella G. about 1958, and they lived in Downingtown in Chester County Pennsylvania. He worked for Simplex Time Recorder Company for thirty years. <sup>17</sup>

Barry was 67 years old when he died April 17<sup>th</sup> 2010 at the Paoli Hospital in Chester County. He was laid to rest at the Susquehanna Memorial Gardens in York Pennsylvania.

Barry and Stella had three children.

1. Dino Einsig who married Lisa
2. Cindy Lou Einsig who married Lymus Gray
3. Desiree Einsig who married Joe Serafino

#### Nettie Cecilio Einsig (1905 - 1954)

Nettie Cecelio Arnold was born November 5<sup>th</sup> 1905 to Joseph Leo Einsig and Emma Jane Wire in York Pennsylvania. <sup>18</sup>

Nettie married Robert Franklin Arnold, and when her father died in 1943 she lived on East King Street in York. <sup>19</sup> Robert was born August 21<sup>st</sup> 1898 <sup>vii</sup> to Adam Arnold and Hattie May Morningstar. When Robert signed up for the WW I draft on September 12<sup>th</sup> 1918, he was living with his mother at 704 East King Street in York. At the time he was a laborer for the York Safe and Lock Company on Loucks Mill Road in York. <sup>20</sup>

In 1940 the couple lived at 707 East King Street in York, where Robert was a laborer for a local manufacturer.

Nettie was 48 years old when she died at the West Side Osteopathic Hospital on October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1954. She was laid to rest October 6<sup>th</sup> at the Mount Rose Cemetery. Her husband was the informant on the death certificate. <sup>21</sup> FAG#:43969889

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<sup>vii</sup> Robert's social security death index indicated his birth date was August 21<sup>st</sup> 1899.

Robert died in November 1967,<sup>22</sup> and was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery. FAG#:43969857

Nettie and Robert Arnold's children included:

- i. Pauline S. Arnold was born in 1924. She was not with the family in 1940.
- ii. Robert Edward Arnold was born October 20<sup>th</sup> 1926. He died January 1984.<sup>23</sup>
- iii. Joseph Walter Arnold was born November 24<sup>th</sup> 1931. He died July 28<sup>th</sup> 1997.<sup>24</sup>

### Pauline M. Einsig (1908-1978 )

Pauline M. Einsig<sup>25</sup> was born May 16<sup>th</sup> 1908 to Joseph Leo Einsig and Emma Jane Wire in York Pennsylvania.<sup>26</sup>

She married Lester Martin Tyson,<sup>27</sup> and when her father died in 1943 she lived on South Sherman Street in York.<sup>28</sup> Lester was born May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1908 to Samuel M. Tyson and Emma E. Grove at R.D.#2 Red Lion in North Hopewell Township York County Pennsylvania. His mother and father were both born in York County.<sup>29</sup>

In 1930 the family lived rented a home in Conewago Township in York County Pennsylvania. By 1932 the family was renting a home at 716 East Market Street in York. In 1940 the family moved to 138 South Sherman Street in York. Lester worked for a Chain factory, where he was a laborer and shipping clerk.

Lester died September 1969,<sup>30</sup> and was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York.<sup>31</sup>

Pauline died October 1978,<sup>32</sup> and was laid to rest with her husband at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York.<sup>33</sup>

Pauline and Lester Tyson's children included:

- i. Lester Martin Tyson Jr. was born February 20<sup>th</sup> 1927 in York Pennsylvania. He was 5 years old when Lester got an infection on his left eye lid. Lester died at home from Cavernous sinus thrombosis<sup>viii</sup> on July 24<sup>th</sup> 1932. He was laid to rest July 27<sup>th</sup> at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York. His father was the informant on his death certificate.<sup>34</sup> FAG#:158192793

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<sup>viii</sup> Cavernous sinus thrombosis (CST) is the formation of a blood clot within the cavernous sinus, a cavity at the base of the brain which drains deoxygenated blood from the brain back to the heart. The cause is usually from a spreading infection in the nose, sinuses, ears, or teeth.

- ii. Ervin Richard Tyson was born February 1<sup>st</sup> 1930 in Zions View York Pennsylvania. Ervin died November 17<sup>th</sup> 1997. <sup>35</sup> He was laid to rest in Plot: K-15-3 at the Mount Zion Cemetery in Springettsbury Township, York County Pennsylvania. FAG#:122364550

### Albert Harry Einsig (1911-1975)

Albert Harry Einsig <sup>36</sup> was born July 29<sup>th</sup> 1911 <sup>37</sup> to Joseph Leo Einsig and Emma Jane Wire in York Pennsylvania.

Albert lived with his family in 1920 and 1930, and when he was 23 years old he married 27 year old Florence Louise Briggs on December 12<sup>th</sup> 1934 in York Pennsylvania. <sup>38</sup> Florence was born December 23<sup>rd</sup> 1907 <sup>39</sup> to George W. Briggs and Alice M. Boll in York County Pennsylvania. <sup>40</sup> Florence was previously married, and her husband died on March 14<sup>th</sup> 1931.

The young family purchased a home, and lived at 740 East King Street in York. Albert worked as a iron steel and junk dealer. When his father died in 1943, Albert lived at 740 East King Street in York.

Albert died October 1975, <sup>41</sup> and he was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. FAG#:98858877

Florence died in October 1984, <sup>42</sup> and she was laid to rest with her husband at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. FAG#:98858895

Albert and Florence did not have any children.
