

## John William Einsig (1871-1917)

John William Einsig <sup>1</sup> was born December 18<sup>th</sup> 1871 to John George Einzig and Theresa Berger <sup>2</sup> in the Freystown <sup>1</sup> area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. <sup>3</sup> John went by the name William.

William was 18 years old when his father provided consent for William to marry 21 year old Caroline (Carrie) Lark on March 28<sup>th</sup> 1890 in York Pennsylvania. <sup>4</sup> Caroline was born January 3<sup>rd</sup> 1867 to Joseph Lark and Margaret Smith in York Pennsylvania. Caroline's father was born in York Pennsylvania and her mother in Baltimore Maryland. <sup>5</sup>

Like so many of his family members, William was a basket maker. The family could not be located, except for Herman who was living with his grandparents, Joseph and Margaret Lark in York. In 1904 William and his family lived at 754 East King Street.

William was living at 748 East Mason Avenue in York Pennsylvania when he died September 4<sup>th</sup> 1917. John was laid to rest September 8<sup>th</sup> 1917 at the Prospect Hill cemetery in York Pennsylvania. His son, Joseph H. Einsig, was the informant on his death certificate. <sup>6</sup> FAG#:128508858 <sup>ii</sup>

When Carrie's son, Robert, registered for the WW I draft in 1918, the family lived at 137 South Sherman Street in York Pennsylvania. <sup>7</sup> By 1920 Carrie was still living at 137 South Sherman Street, and except for her daughter Margaret, all of her children lived with her, including her daughter Edith, and her husband Earl Pritz and daughter Madeline Pritz.

In 1930 Carrie lived next door to her son Erwin at 709 Edison Street in York Pennsylvania. Living with Carrie were her sons: Herman who was single, Joseph who was married, George who was single, and Herbert who was divorced.

Carrie was 75 years old, living at 709 Edison Street in York, when she died March 19<sup>th</sup> 1940. She was laid to rest March 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Her son Erwin Einsig of 202 Pattison Street in York was the informant on her death certificate. <sup>8</sup> FAG#:98858888 <sup>iii</sup>

In the 1910 census Carrie indicated she had ten children and nine where still living.

- i. Herman Einsig was born in June 1887. In 1900 he was living with his grandparents, Joseph and Margaret Lark, at 623 East King Street in York Pennsylvania. He could not be found in 1910.

In 1930 Herman was single and living with his mother, Carrie, and his brothers Joseph, George and Herbert, at 709 Edison Street in York Pennsylvania. They lived next door to his brother, Ervin's family.

Freystown became part of York city around 1900 (sources vary), but not without reluctance.

Like his father, Herman was a basket maker. He cannot be located after 1930.

- ii. Joseph Harry Einsig<sup>9</sup> was born December 24<sup>th</sup> 1889<sup>iv</sup> to William Einsig and Caroline Lark in York, York County Pennsylvania.<sup>10</sup>

Joseph was 30 years old when he married 19 year old Ruth Catherine Kanter on May 7<sup>th</sup> 1920 in Lebanon County Pennsylvania. Ruth was born in 1901 to Frank Kanter and Minnie Focht.<sup>11</sup>

In 1930 Joseph was married, but living with his mother, Carrie, and his brothers Herman, George and Herbert, at 709 Edison Street in York Pennsylvania. They lived next door to his brother, Ervin's family.

Like his father and his brother Herman, Joseph was a basket maker.

Joseph lived at 723 Phillips Place in York. He was 71 years old when he died September 6<sup>th</sup> 1961 at Pleasant Acres in Springettsbury Township York County Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest September 9<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. Mary Reamer of Pleasant Acres was the informant on his death certificate.<sup>12</sup> FAG#:154172697

- iii. Albert Earl Einsig<sup>v</sup> was born December 7<sup>th</sup> 1892<sup>vi</sup> to William Einsig and Caroline Lark in York, York County Pennsylvania.<sup>13</sup> Albert was 21 years old when he married 18 year old May Grove April 18<sup>th</sup> 1915 in York Pennsylvania.<sup>14</sup> At some time prior to 1919, Albert and May were no longer married, and Albert married Catherine M. Gotwalt.

Like many of his family members, Albert was a basket maker. He was a private in the 7<sup>th</sup> Battalion Infantry Replacement Training Camp during WW I.

Albert lived briefly with his daughter Carrie Green of 731 East Clark Avenue in York.

Albert was 62 years old when he died at his daughter's home on October 12<sup>th</sup> 1955. He was laid to rest October 14<sup>th</sup> at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York. His daughter Carrie was the informant on Albert's death certificate.<sup>15</sup> FAG#:42021579<sup>vii</sup>

Albert and Catherine had thirteen children.<sup>viii</sup>

- a. Albert Earl Einsig II was born September 18<sup>th</sup> 1920 in York Pennsylvania. He married Vivian Jean Alban in 1962. Albert served in the U.S. Navy and was a retired Pennsylvania Railroad worker.

Albert was 93 years old when he died Sunday May 4<sup>th</sup> 2014 at his home in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest Thursday May 8<sup>th</sup> at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania.<sup>16</sup>

- iv. Edith M.<sup>ix</sup> Einsig was born 1894 in York, York County Pennsylvania. She was 20 years old when she married 24 year old Earl E. Pritz on July 11<sup>th</sup> 1914 in York Pennsylvania. Earl was born in 1891. He was previously married, which ended in divorce due to adultery in July 6<sup>th</sup> 1914.<sup>17</sup>

In 1920 the Pritz family lived with Edith's mother, Carrie, at 137 South Sherman Street in York Pennsylvania. Edith died in 1964, and was laid to rest at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania.<sup>18</sup> FAG#:108191902 Her husband Earl died in 1967, and was laid with Edith at Prospect Hill cemetery.<sup>19</sup> FAG#:108191901

Edith and Earl Pritz's children included:

- a. Madeline M. Pritz who was born September 9<sup>th</sup> 1914 in York Pennsylvania. The family lived at 217 Fulton Street in York when, at seven years old, she died November 20<sup>th</sup> 1921. Madeline was laid to rest November 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Her father Earl was the informant on Madeline's death certificate.<sup>20</sup>
- v. Ervin Earl Einsig was born December 3<sup>rd</sup> 1896 in 1897<sup>x</sup> to William Einsig and Caroline Lark in York, York County Pennsylvania. In 1918 he lived at 615 State Street in York Pennsylvania, and worked for the Keystone roofing Company. His mother carried was listed on his WW I draft registration as his nearest relative.<sup>21</sup>

Ervin married Alma K. Sipe on January 9<sup>th</sup> 1918 in York Pennsylvania. <sup>22</sup> Alma was born August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1899. <sup>23</sup>

In 1920 the family lived at 703 Rilison Street in York Pennsylvania, where Ervin worked as a laborer for a chain company.

In 1930 Ervin was a laborer in a junk yard, while his brothers, George and Herbert, were buyers of Junk. At that time Ervin's family live next door to his mother, Carrie, and his brothers Joseph, Herman, George, and Herbert who lived at 709 Edison Street in York Pennsylvania.

By 1940 Ervin's family lived at 202 Pattison Street in York Pennsylvania.

Ervin died in September 1972, <sup>24</sup> and was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. <sup>25</sup> FAG#:152727113 Alma died in May 1978, <sup>26</sup> and was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. <sup>27</sup> FAG#: 152727144

Their children included:

- c. Florence E. Einsig was born April 28<sup>th</sup> 1921. She died September 13<sup>th</sup> 1921 in Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. Florence was laid to rest September 15<sup>th</sup> at the Mount Zion Church Cemetery in Springettsbury Township, York County Pennsylvania <sup>xi</sup> Her father, Ervin, was the informant of the death certificate. <sup>28</sup> FAG#:154216671
- d. Edith E. Einsig was born November 12<sup>th</sup> 1922 in York Pennsylvania. <sup>29</sup> She married in 1948 to Leroy E. Bievenour. Leroy was born June 17<sup>th</sup> 1923 to Raymond P. Bievenour and Lucy E. Moul in Dover, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>30</sup>

Edith was the manager of the children's department at Montgomery Wards until her retirement. She enjoyed cooking, painting, gardening, and sewing, along with raising five children.

Edith was 91 when she died Tuesday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014, where she had been a resident at Normandie Ridge Assisted Living. She was laid to rest at the Suburban Memorial Gardens in Dover, York County Pennsylvania. FAG#:108694003

- vi. Margaret Einsig was born in 1899. She was with the family in 1910, but not with her mother in 1920.
- vii. Robert William Einsig <sup>31</sup> was born January 17<sup>th</sup> 1899 to William Einsig and Caroline Lark in York, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>32</sup> Robert married Sadie E. Topper, who was born October 26<sup>th</sup> 1910 to William David Topper and Sadie Lau in York Pennsylvania. <sup>33</sup>

When Robert registered for the WW I draft in 1918, he lived with his mother at 137 South Sherman Street in York Pennsylvania. <sup>34</sup> The family lived at 752 East Mason Avenue and 716 East Market Street in York Pennsylvania.

Robert was 27 years old when he married 16 year old Sadie Elizabeth <sup>35</sup> Topper on August 21<sup>st</sup> 1926 in York Pennsylvania. <sup>36</sup> Sadie was born October 26<sup>th</sup> 1910 to David William Topper and Sadie Lau. <sup>37</sup>

In 1930 the family lived with a 41 year old divorcee, Bessie Shapiro, at 138 South Newberry Street in York Pennsylvania. At the time Robert had his own business as a junk dealer, and most likely worked with his other brothers who were also in the junk business. By 1940 the family lived at 715 East Mason Avenue in York, where Robert was still in his own junk business.

Sadie was 47 years old when she died August 29<sup>th</sup> 1958 at the York Hospital. She was laid to rest September 1<sup>st</sup> at the St. Jacobs Union Church Cemetery in New Salem Borough of York. Her husband Robert was the informant on the death certificate. <sup>38</sup> FAG#:110378813 <sup>xii</sup>

Robert was 95 years old when he died in September 17<sup>th</sup> 1994. <sup>39</sup> He was laid to rest at the Mount Zion Church Cemetery in Springettsbury Township, York County Pennsylvania <sup>xiii</sup>

- a. Doris M Einsig <sup>40</sup> was still-born on November 28<sup>th</sup> 1926 to Robert Einsig and Sadie E. Topper at 819 East Boundary Avenue in York, York County Pennsylvania. The child was laid to rest November 29<sup>th</sup> at the New Salem Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. <sup>xiv</sup> Mrs. Sadie M. Topper of 104 South Newberry Street in York was the informant on the child's death certificate. <sup>41</sup> FAG#:110378811
- b. Mary Anita Einsig was born seven months premature on May 7<sup>th</sup> 1939 to Robert Einsig and Sadie Topper at the York Hospital York Pennsylvania. Mary died May 28<sup>th</sup> 1939 while at the hospital. She was laid to rest on May 19<sup>th</sup>, with her sister Doris, at the New Salem Cemetery in York. Her father, Robert, was the informant on the death certificate. <sup>42</sup> FAG#:110378812
- c. Jean E. Einsig was born December 1927.
- d. Robert Einsig was born about 1935.

In 1930 George indicated that he was a buyer of Junk, like his brother Herbert. Their other brother Ervin was a laborer in a Junk Yard.

- ix. Herbert William Einsig was born May 17<sup>th</sup> 1904<sup>43</sup> to William Einsig and Caroline Lark in York, York County Pennsylvania.

Herbert married Mary M. Pfaltzgeaff (Pfaltzgraff) on April 26<sup>th</sup> 1926 in York Pennsylvania.<sup>44</sup>

By 1930 Herbert was divorced and living with his mother, Carrie, at 709 Edison Street in York Pennsylvania. They lived next door to his brother, Ervin and his family. Herbert indicated that he was a buyer of Junk, like his brother George. Their other brother Ervin was a laborer in a Junk Yard.

Herbert then married Ruth Gordon.

Herbert was 85 years old when he died July 13<sup>th</sup> 1989 while living in Fort Pierce Florida.<sup>45</sup> He was laid to rest at the Riverview Memorial Park in Fort Pierce, St. Lucie County Florida.<sup>46</sup> FAG#:124048513 Ruth was born March 16<sup>th</sup> 1904, and died July 6<sup>th</sup> 1985. She was laid to rest with her husband.<sup>47</sup> FAG#:124048292

Herbert and Mary Pfaltzgraff had these children:

- a. Unnamed Male Einsig was stillborn,<sup>xv</sup> as a twin, on July 14<sup>th</sup> 1926 in York Pennsylvania. The child was laid to rest July 17<sup>th</sup> at Greenmount Cemetery in York. The child's grandfather, Charles W. Pfaltzgeaff, of 1398 North Popular Street in York was the informant on the death certificate.<sup>48</sup>
  - b. Unnamed Male Einsig was born premature, as a twin, on July 14<sup>th</sup> 1926 in York Pennsylvania. The child was laid to rest July 17<sup>th</sup> at Greenmount Cemetery in York. The child's grandfather, Charles W. Pfaltzgeaff, of 1398 North Popular Street in York was the informant on the death certificate.<sup>49</sup>
- x. Melvin Einsig was born June 2<sup>nd</sup> 1907<sup>50</sup> to William Einsig and Carrie Lark in York Pennsylvania.

In 1920 Melvin lived with his mother, but by 1930 he was married to Anna (b.1909) and they lived with Melvin's brother Hebert (Harry) and his wife Ester, at 736 East King Street in York Pennsylvania. Melvin and Anna married about 1927.

Melvin died January 5<sup>th</sup> 1971. He was laid to rest at the Fairview Cemetery in Wrightsville York County Pennsylvania.<sup>51</sup> FAG#:132542717

He was 88 years old when he died August 31<sup>st</sup> 2002. He was laid to rest at the Mount Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. <sup>53</sup>
