

## Samuel Arnold (1809 – 1884)

Samuel Arnold was born October 11<sup>th</sup> 1809 <sup>1</sup> to George Arnold and his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife Maria Carl in the Dillsburg <sup>2</sup>area of Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania.

Samuel married Marie Ann Lau on March 8<sup>th</sup> 1832 in Franklinton, <sup>3</sup> Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. Marie also went by the name Mary, who was born after the month of June in 1823. <sup>4</sup>

Samuel was a farmer and lived between Franklinton and Clear Springs.

Samuel died June 14<sup>th</sup> 1884, and was laid to rest in the Franklin Church Cemetery, Clear Springs, Franklin Township York County. <sup>5</sup> Inscription: Birth and Death Dates, Our Father, Aged 74 Yrs. 8 Mos. & 3 Days FAG#: 73675808 <sup>i</sup>

By 1900 Mary was living with her son, Martin, at 215 West Locust Street in Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>6</sup>

By 1903 Mary Ann had seven children, twenty-five grandchildren, and fifty-one great grandchildren.

Mary was 80 years old when she died in the early hours of June 24<sup>th</sup> 1903 in the home of her son, Martin Arnold, at West Locust Street Mechanicsburg. Funeral were held at 10 a.m. on Friday, June 26<sup>th</sup> at the home of her son, Martin. Mary Ann was laid to rest June 26<sup>th</sup> in the Mechanicsburg Cemetery. <sup>7</sup> FAG#: 107683207 <sup>ii</sup>

In 1900 Mary Ann indicated she had seven children and seven children were still living. Her obituary also indicated these children, and their residences. <sup>8</sup>

- iii. Martin Lau Arnold was born about 1837. He married Elizabeth Ann.

## Henry Lau Arnold (1834-1904)

Henry Lau Arnold was born about 1834 to Samuel Arnold and Mary Ann Lau in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania.

Henry was a carpenter when he married Mary Miller on September 14<sup>th</sup> 1854 by Reverend John Ulrich <sup>iii</sup> at the Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in York Springs, Adams County Pennsylvania. <sup>10</sup>

Mary was born 1837 <sup>11</sup> to Henry and Elizabeth Miller. <sup>12</sup>

Henry was a Civil War veteran, and was drafted in York County October 25<sup>th</sup> 1862, mustered into federal service at York November 8<sup>th</sup> as a private with Co. H, 166th Pennsylvania Infantry (aka "Drafted Militia"). He was honorably discharged with his company July 28<sup>th</sup> 1863, in York.

Henry then enlisted in Franklinton, York County, August 24<sup>th</sup> 1864, and mustered into federal service at Harrisburg August 29<sup>th</sup> 1864 as a private with Co. I, 209th Pennsylvania Infantry. He was promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> lieutenant September 13<sup>th</sup> 1864, and honorably discharged with his company May 31<sup>st</sup> 1865. <sup>13</sup>

- My GG-Grandfather Michael Wrightstone, and his brother John, were also in the 166<sup>th</sup> and 209<sup>th</sup> regiments.

Henry and Mary moved from York County to live in Dauphin County in Harrisburg. By 1880 the family was living 38 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. In 1887 Henry L. Arnold and his family were living at 229 South 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Harrisburg, where he was a carpenter. <sup>14</sup>

By 1900 the family lived at 1629 Derry Street in Harrisburg. <sup>15</sup>

Henry died in 1904, and was laid to rest in East Harrisburg Cemetery, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. FAG#: 40404846 <sup>iv</sup>

Mary died in 1905, and was laid to rest with her husband at the East Harrisburg Cemetery, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. FAG#: 40404847 <sup>v</sup>

In 1900 Mary indicated she had five children, but only 4 were still living.

Henry and Mary Arnold's children included:

- i. Amanda Arnold was born 1851.
- ii. Edwin Miller Arnold was born June 15<sup>th</sup> 1856 to Henry Arnold and Mary Miller in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>16</sup> He married Anna Riffel, and they lived in 1927 Swatara Street in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Edwin worked for the railroad company as a car washer. Edwin was 84 years old when he died November 9<sup>th</sup> 1940. He was laid to rest November 12<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery, Harrisburg. Francis R. Arnold, of 127 South 14<sup>th</sup> Street Harrisburg, was the informant on Edwin's death certificate. <sup>17</sup> FAG#: 169897521 <sup>vi</sup>
- iii. Sarah E. Arnold was born 1862 to Henry Arnold and Mary Miller in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. She went by the name Sadie, who lived with the family at 229 South 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Harrisburg. <sup>18</sup> When at 24 years old, on December 7<sup>th</sup> 1886, Sadie applied to be married to 25-year-old (b. 1861) Fredrick S. Ulrich. Then on December 20<sup>th</sup> 1886 they were married by Reverend N. C. Phillips in Harrisburg. <sup>19</sup>

By 1900 the family was living in West Pikeland Township, Chester County Pennsylvania. Fredrick was working as an engineer for an electric light company.

Sarah E. Ulrich died May 16<sup>th</sup> 1947 while living in White Plains, Westchester County, New York. She was laid to rest in Plot Section 39 of the East Harrisburg Cemetery, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. <sup>20</sup> FAG#: 122006688 <sup>vii</sup>

Frederick S. Ulrich died September 8<sup>th</sup> 1947 <sup>21</sup> in White Plains, Westchester County, New York. She was laid to rest in Plot Section 39 of the East Harrisburg Cemetery, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. FAG#: 125544648 <sup>viii</sup>

Fredrick and Sadie Ulrich's children included:

In 1900 Sadie indicated she had two children, who were both still living. By 1910 Sadie indicated she had four children and three were still living.

- iv. Cora M. Arnold was born March 7<sup>th</sup> 1866 to Henry Arnold and Mary Miller in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. She was married to John C. Ward, and they lived in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Cora was 56 years old when she died December 26<sup>th</sup> 1922. She was laid to rest December 29<sup>th</sup> at the East Harrisburg Cemetery, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.<sup>22</sup> FAG#: 125625474 <sup>ix</sup>
- v. Mary Stella Arnold was born October 13<sup>th</sup> 1870 to Henry Arnold and Mary Miller in Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.<sup>23</sup> Her name was also recorded as Stella M. She lived with her family her entire adult life, and never married. In 1900 she was living with her parents at 1629 Derry street in Harrisburg. After her parents died, Mary continued to live in the family home.

Mary was 67 years old when she died at her Derry Street home in Harrisburg on March 23<sup>rd</sup> 1938. She was laid to rest in the East Harrisburg Cemetery, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. Mrs. Stella M. Kauffman, of 1108 North 16<sup>th</sup> Street Harrisburg, was the informant on Mary's death certificate.<sup>24</sup> FAG#: 40404848 <sup>x</sup>

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## Martin Lau Arnold (1837-1916)

Martin Lau Arnold was born September 3<sup>rd</sup> 1837 to Samuel Arnold and Mary Ann Lau in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>25</sup> He was named after his uncle, Martin Arnold (1818-1896). <sup>26</sup>

Martin was married to Amanda prior to his June 1863 his civil war draft registration. She was born in 1834. <sup>27</sup>

Martin <sup>xi</sup>was a Civil War veteran and a carpenter, who stood 5' 8" tall and had black hair and gray eyes. He lived in Carroll Township, York County, Pennsylvania when he enlisted into the Civil War on August 31<sup>st</sup> 1864 in Franklintown Franklin Township, York County. Martin mustered into federal service at Harrisburg September 6<sup>th</sup> as a corporal with I Company I of the 209<sup>th</sup> Pennsylvania Infantry. He was honorably discharged with his company May 31<sup>st</sup> in 1865. <sup>28</sup>

Sometime after the civil war, martin and Amanda went to live in Mechanics, and by 1889 he had been a member of Zinn Post, No. 415, G.A.R.

Amanda died in 1898, and was laid to rest in the Mechanicsburg cemetery. <sup>29</sup> FAG#: 107683084 <sup>xii</sup>

In 1900 Martin indicated he was a widower who had been married for 40 years. He lived with his mother Mary Ann at 215 West Locust Street in Mechanicsburg. <sup>30</sup>

Martin was 79 years old when he died on November 11<sup>th</sup> 1916 in Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest November 15<sup>th</sup> in the Mechanicsburg Cemetery, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Ruth Howard, of Mechanicsburg, was the informant on his death certificate. <sup>31</sup> FAG#: 93111063 <sup>xiii</sup>

Martin and Amanda Arnold's children included:

- i. Mary Elizabeth Arnold <sup>32</sup> was born about 1863 to Martin and Amanda in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. She was 25 years old when she married 35-year-old Luther G. Howard on January 31<sup>st</sup> 1888 by Reverend Augusts Bobb in Mechanicsburg. <sup>33</sup>

Luther was born April 17<sup>th</sup> 1852 to William and Elizabeth Howard in Adams County Pennsylvania. <sup>34</sup>

Mary died 1898, and was laid to rest in Plot D25 of the Mechanicsburg Cemetery Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. FAG#: 167900321 <sup>xiv</sup>

Luther then moved, and bought a home, and lived at 512 Curtin Street in Harrisburg, Dauphin County.

Luther died October 4<sup>th</sup> 1935 at his home. He was laid to rest October 7<sup>th</sup> with his wife in Plot D25 of the Mechanicsburg Cemetery. Jessie H. Keller, of 512 Curtin Street in Harrisburg, was the informant on Luther's death certificate. <sup>35</sup> FAG#: 167900063 <sup>xv</sup>

Mary and Luther Howard's children included:

- a. Mary E. Howard was born September 1<sup>st</sup> 1888 in Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. She married Arthur Lloyd Foose. They lived at 48 West Simpson Street, Mechanicsburg.

Mary was 75 years old when she died February 3<sup>rd</sup> 1964, and was laid to rest February 6<sup>th</sup> in the Mechanicsburg Cemetery Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. Her husband, of 48 West Simpson Street Mechanicsburg, was the informant on her death certificate. <sup>36</sup> FAG#: 107766858 <sup>xvi</sup>

- b. Jessie Arnold Howard <sup>37</sup> was born March 18<sup>th</sup> 1890 in Mechanicsburg. <sup>38</sup>

Jessie married James Dale Fink, of Mechanicsburg, on May 28<sup>th</sup> 1910 in York Pennsylvania. James was born about 1887 to William H. and Sadie E. Fink. <sup>39</sup> Jessie divorced James in the September Term of 1920 No. 5 in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. <sup>40</sup>

Jessie was 38 years old, living at 203 North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street in Harrisburg, and working as an information clerk. She then married Oliver P. Keller Jr. on June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1928 by Reverend Max. C. Wyant in Harrisburg. <sup>41</sup>

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Oliver was born about 1889 to Oliver P. Keller Sr. and Minnie Miller in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Oliver was previously married <sup>42</sup> to Mary M. Baker of Carroll Township, York County Pennsylvania. Oliver and Mary married October 15<sup>th</sup> 1908 in Harrisburg. <sup>43</sup> Mary died January 25<sup>th</sup> 1927. <sup>44</sup>

- Oliver and his wife Mary had these children: James Keller (b. 1909) and Oliver P. Keller Jr. (b.1916)

At the time of his marriage to Jessie, Oliver was living at 512 Curtin Street in Harrisburg, and worked as a machinist for the railroad. His parents were both living in Lemoyne, Cumberland County, and they were both born in Lancaster County Pennsylvania. <sup>45</sup>

In 1930 Jessie, and her Husband Oliver P. Keller, was living with her father, Luther Howard, at 512 Curtin Street in Harrisburg, Dauphin County. Also living with them were James Keller (b. 1909) and Oliver P. Keller Jr. (b.1916)

Oliver died in 1973, and was laid to rest in East Harrisburg Cemetery, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania: FAG#: 124159043

We were unable to locate Jesse, but she did file a claim for Luther in 1973. <sup>46</sup>

- c. Ruth Howard was born in 1897. In 1920 she lived with her Aunt, Mary Ellen Arnold, at 215 West Locust Street in Mechanicsburg. Ruth was the informant on her grandfather's death certificate.



## George Arnold (1840-1916)

George Arnold was born October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1840 to Samuel Arnold and Mary Ann Lau in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>47</sup>

In 1860 George lived with his family in Franklin Township, York County, Pennsylvania, and like his father, worked as a carpenter. He stood 5' 8" tall and had light hair and hazel eyes. A Civil War veteran, he enlisted in Harrisburg July 13, 1864, mustered into federal service there July 20 as a private with Co. G, 194th Pennsylvania Infantry, and honorably discharged with his company November 6, 1864. <sup>48</sup>

George married Elizabeth Dentler October 22, 1867, in Dillsburg, York County. Elizabeth Dentler was born September 24<sup>th</sup> 1838 to Jacob Dentler and Miss. Miller in York County Pennsylvania. <sup>49</sup>

Soon after they married the family moved to Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. When his mother died in 1903 George was living in Mechanicsburg. <sup>50</sup> By 1910 George was still working as a carpenter, living at 41 West Green Street in Mechanicsburg.

George died December 7<sup>th</sup> 1916, of gangrene of left foot" with a contributing factor of "erysipelas", in Mechanicsburg. He was laid to rest December 10<sup>th</sup> in Plot P6 at the Mechanicsburg Cemetery Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. George's son, Charley, was the informant on George's death certificate. <sup>51</sup> FAG#: 93110708 <sup>xvii</sup>

Elizabeth was 78 years old when she died March 29<sup>th</sup> 1917, and was laid to rest in Plot P6 at the Mechanicsburg Cemetery Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. Her son William Arnold was the informant on her death certificate. <sup>52</sup> FAG#: 94055654 <sup>xviii</sup>

In 1900 Elizabeth indicated she had six children, but only five were still living. Then in 1910 Elizabeth indicated she had three children, and all three were still living.

George and Elizabeth Arnold's children include:

- i. Amos Arnold was born September 27<sup>th</sup> 1868 to George Arnold and Elizabeth Dentler on August 6<sup>th</sup> 1872 in Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>53</sup>

Amos never married, and worked as a policeman in Mechanicsburg. Prior to 1900 Amos lived with his parents in Mechanicsburg. After 1900 he began to live at the National Hotel <sup>xix</sup> in Mechanicsburg.

Amos was 75 years old when he died December 17<sup>th</sup> 1943 at the Seidle Memorial Hospital in Mechanicsburg. He was laid to rest on December 21<sup>st</sup> at the Mechanicsburg Cemetery Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. Amos's brother, W. H. Arnold, of Mechanicsburg, was the informant on Amos's death certificate. <sup>54</sup>

- ii. William Henry Arnold <sup>55</sup> was born August 6<sup>th</sup> 1872 to George Arnold and Elizabeth Dentler in Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>56</sup> He lived with the family in 1900.

William was 31 years old when he married 23-year-old Jane L. Shuler (Bessie Jane) on October 7<sup>th</sup> 1902 in Mechanicsburg. Jane's mother was deceased when they married, and Jane indicated she was previously married, and her husband died in October 1896. <sup>57</sup> Bessie Jane Shuler was born April 4<sup>th</sup> 1879 to John Shuler <sup>xxi</sup> in Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>58</sup>

In 1910 the young family lived at 308 West Allen Street Mechanicsburg, and they continued to live in Mechanicsburg for some time before moving to Lemoyne, Cumberland County Pennsylvania.

Bessie was 70 years old, living at 322 Plum Street in Lemoyne, when she died January 17<sup>th</sup> 1950. She was laid to rest January 20<sup>th</sup> at the Mechanicsburg Cemetery Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. Bessie's daughter, Mrs. W. H. Miller, of 416 Hummel Avenue Lemoyne, was the informant on Bessie's death certificate. <sup>59</sup> FAG#: 107683102 <sup>xxii</sup>

William was widower, and retired from a shoe factory, living at 416 Herman Avenue in Lemoyne, Cumberland County, when he died at the Harrisburg Hospital on November 29<sup>th</sup> 1954. He was laid to rest December 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Mechanicsburg Cemetery Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. His daughter, Mrs. W. H. Miller, of 416 Hummel Avenue Lemoyne, was the informant on the death certificate. <sup>60</sup>

In 1910 Bessie indicated she had three children, but only one was still living. She may have had children through her previous marriage.

- a. Stella I. Arnold was born in 1906. She married William H. Miller, and by 1930 Stella and William had a son; William H. Miller Jr. who was born about 1925; Arleen E. Miller who was born about 1927; Alvin L. Miller who was born about 1929.
- iii. Charles E. Arnold was born August 28<sup>th</sup> 1882 born to George Arnold and Elizabeth Dentler in Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>61</sup> Charles lived with his parents until he married.

Charles was a 22-year-old baker when he married September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1904 to 20-year-old Arrie Irene Finkenbinder in Carlisle, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>62</sup> Airie Irene Finkenbinder was born November 1<sup>st</sup> 1884 to Andrew Finkenbinder and Catherine Diehl in Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>63</sup>

By 1910 the family lived on West Green Street in Mechanicsburg. By 1920 the family moved to 603 Boas Street in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

Charles and Arrie lived at 601 Herr Street in Harrisburg, where he was a barber. Charles was 41 years old when he died June 1<sup>st</sup> 1924. He was laid to rest June 4<sup>thin</sup> Plot Section A, lot 213 west, space 4 of the Westminster Memorial Gardens Carlisle, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. <sup>64</sup> FAG#: 90770845 <sup>xxiv</sup>

After Charles died and Airie remarried to John Montgomery Giffen on June 18<sup>th</sup> 1927 in Carlisle, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. <sup>65</sup>

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Mrs. Griffin was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church and the Sunday School. Airie Irene Arnold-Giffen was 80 years old when she died Sunday, October 1965 at the Carlisle Hospital.

Funeral service was held on Wednesday at 2 p.m. in the Ewing Brothers Funeral Home, 630 South Hanover Street. The Rev. Dr. Elmer P. Truchses, her pastor officiated. Airie was laid to rest with her husband, Charles Arnold, in Plot Section A, lot 213 west, space 5 of the Westminster Memorial Gardens Carlisle. <sup>66</sup> FAG#: 90770852

Finkenbinder, Harrisburg; a sister, Mrs. Mattie Shank, Carlisle; several step-grandchildren and several step-great-grandchildren.

In 1910 Arrie indicated she had no children, and they had no children prior to Charles Arnold's death in 1924.

## Susan A. Arnold (1844-1933)

Susan A. Arnold was born February 12<sup>th</sup> 1844 to Samuel Arnold and Mary Ann Lau in Franklin Township, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>67</sup>

Susan married Alfred Kapp about 1863. Alfred was born April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1842 <sup>68</sup> to George and Elizabeth Kapp in Franklin Township York County Pennsylvania. In 1860 his Kapp family lived in Latimore Township, Adams County Pennsylvania, <sup>xxv</sup> where Alfred was a mason.

During the Civil War, Alfred enlisted August 20<sup>th</sup> 1864 in Franklinton, Franklin Township, York County.
